DAY 1: FRIDAY, 5TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: CONSECRATION; A PREREQUISITE FOR DOMINION

EXHORTATION:

Genesis 1 :26-28: And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

James 4:7: Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

God's unchanging heart for mankind is to have man rule over all that He had created, in the air, under the sea or on the surface of the earth. The requirement for dominion is for man to submit to God and to continue to be in the image and likeness of God. As long as Adam was in submission to God, he retained the likeness of God and was able to exercise dominion over all things. The ability to have dominion was lost when he gave in to Satan because he wasn't in total submission to God, as a result, he lost his dominion grip over situations around him, and evil pervaded the world.

Today, being the first day as we fast and pray for the year, we would be bringing ourselves under full submission to God as we consecrate our lives to Him. A man who is fully submitted to the will of God will be able to exercise dominion over all things just like it was in the beginning. James encourages us in James 4:7, to first of all submit ourselves to God after which we can resist the devil and then he will flee. The devil and situations around us will only bow to the man who is under authority to God's rule in his personal life. Remember the story of the Centurion in Matt 8:5-13 as a man under authority, he could exert dominion over other soldiers. It is only a man under God's authority that is empowered to exercise dominion over the works of the enemy. A policeman in country 'A' can exercise dominion only in his country where he has been empowered to do so; once he crosses over to another territory, he loses the power to exercise his authority in a foreign land.

What happens when we consecrate ourselves in prayer, and pray to grow into the image and likeness of Christ:

- 1) We find wisdom and understand the mind of God to rule as He wants.
- 2) We are able to shine as lights that God has called us to be, and extensions of God's hands and feet in bringing solutions to our world.
- 3) Mountains, situation and circumstances bow to God in us, and we become vessels unto honour, and undiluted channels of His grace.
- 4) We begin the long-awaited manifestation of God's sons which the earth has been long waiting for.

Rom 8:26-27: Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

In this scripture, Paul gave us a very important insight into praying in tongues and its function in the Spirit world. The Holy Spirit is our Helper, Intercessor and Comforter. He is here to help us in every area of our lives and particularly in prayer. Effective prayer must be done according to the will of God and by faith. God does not answer or listen to unbelief.

When Paul uses the word help, he is painting the picture of assistance offered to infants not able to support themselves, or to the feeble, staggering and barely able to walk. It means to relieve those whose strength is insufficient to carry their burden alone. The weakness spoken of here is the believers' inability and inefficiency of how to properly and accurately engage a situation in prayer. Our ultimate weakness is 'not knowing' how to properly pray. This is where in praying in tongues, the Holy Spirit gives assistance in that He knows exactly how to pray about the situation.

During this session, the minister is to ensure he leads the people to pray in tongues for most of the time allotted to prayer. As we consecrate our lives to God in prayer, we bring ourselves under God's authority and then we are empowered and enabled to exercise dominion as we ought.

EXHORTATION:

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As we fast and pray for the year, we would be bringing ourselves under full submission to God as we consecrate our lives to Him. Remember the story of the Centurion in Matt 8:5-13 as a man under authority, he could exert dominion over other soldiers. A policeman in country A can exercise dominion only in his country where he has been empowered to do so; once he crosses over to another territory, he loses the power to exercise his authority in a foreign land.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, 7TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: OUR NATION; PRAYERS FOR ALL MEN

EXHORTATION

1 Tim 2:1-4; 8: I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.I will therefore that men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

The word 'therefore' implies that there's a point Apostle Paul had made earlier which is the reason for giving this instruction to pray for all men and for those in authority.

In the preceding chapter (1Tim 1:11-16), Paul talks about obtaining God's mercy in spite of the fact that he was once a blasphemer, persecutor and injurious to the church and the reason God's grace and mercy found him was because the church took prayers for all men as a priority in their worship.

Paul admonishes, 'first of all', to emphasise that the church should place priority over praying for all men. Paul attributes his salvation and call to ministry to the importance the church placed on prayers for all men. The church wasn't necessarily praying for Paul but because they were engaged in praying for all men, the consequence was that God's mercy was released and delivered Paul. The nations of the earth are at a point where the church is under persecution just like in the days of the early church. The way to go about the evil in the land is by 'first of all', praying for all men. When we begin to do this, it is good and acceptable to God and men will be saved all over the land, including the persecutors of the church. Men everywhere are charged to lift up holy hands for all men in our land; the consequence of this will be multitudes turning to Christ in our nation as the gospel will be preached in every nook and cranny of our nation without any hindrance.

How do we pray for all men? The bible says supplications, prayers, intercessions and giving of thanks; this implies that all manners of prayers are to be made for all men in our land. The only way we can pray for all men in line with the will of God is to pray in other tongues.

Rom 8:26-27: Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings

which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

In this scripture, Paul gave us a very important insight into praying in tongues and its function in the Spirit world. The Holy Spirit is our Helper, Intercessor and Comforter. He is here to help us in every area of our lives and particularly in prayer. Effective prayer has to be done according to the will of God and by faith. God does not answer or listen to unbelief.

When Paul uses the word help, he is painting the picture of assistance offered to infants not able to support themselves, or to the feeble, staggering and barely able to walk. It means to relieve those whose strength is insufficient to carry their burden alone. During this session, the minister is to ensure he leads the people to pray in tongues for most of the time allotted to prayer, sandwiching the prayers in between thanksgiving. As we pray for all men in our land, we should expect a great harvest of souls in our land as we lift holy hands together as God's people.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, 7TH JANUARY 2024

1. PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING: PRAYER FOR ALL MEN IN THE NATION LEAD THE CONGREGATION TO PRAY IN THE UNDERSTANDING AND THEN PROCEED TO PRAY IN THE HOLY GHOST

Lord, we lift up holy hands as your people as we pray for all men in our nation. We acknowledge that we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but we yield ourselves to the Holy Spirit to give us utterance as we begin to pray in other tongues to make supplications, intercessions, prayers, and giving of thanks for all men in our nation. We receive the help of the Holy Spirit right now to pray according to the divine will of God for all men in our nation as we begin to pray in other tongues in Jesus name.

DAY 4: MONDAY, 8TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR THE NATION: PROPHETIC DECLARATIONS

EXHORTATION:

JER 1:9-10: Then the LORD put forth his hand and touched my mouth. And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth. See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

JOB 22:28-29: Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways. When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, there is lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.

Rev 1:6: And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen

God made man in His image and after His likeness to exercise dominion over the earth. For everyone who is a child of God, He has made us kings and priests unto Himself. As priests, we minister unto our God and as kings, we rule and exercise dominion by making decrees. Kings rule and reign by making declarations, they rule by issuing decrees. Jesus confirmed this in Matt 16:19 by declaring that we have the keys of the kingdom to allow or disallow situations and they will come to pass.

With Jeremiah's call came the ability to exercise dominion over nations and kingdoms; he had the power to root out or to build kingdoms by the words of his mouth.

Kings rule by decrees. Where the word of a king is, there is authority; there is power. God has placed us in this nation to exercise our dominion by making decrees, declaring the reign of God's kingdom here on earth.

As we pray today, we will exercise our authority by speaking words over our nation, and as we make decrees over our nation, it shall be established unto us in Jesus name.

How do we effectively pray for our nation?

Rom 8:26-27: Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

In this scripture, Paul gave us a very important insight into praying in tongues and its function in the Spirit world. The Holy Spirit is our Helper, Intercessor and Comforter. - ≡ In Jesus name, the word of God is on our tongue,
- ≡ As kings unto our God, we make decrees over our nation and these decrees are established in Jesus name.
- ≡ We declare over our land that violence shall no longer be heard in this nation.
- ≡ Wasting nor destruction shall no more be within our borders,
- ≡ We decree an end to terrorism, violence, destruction, and wars in the land.
- ≡ We speak peace to every nook and cranny of our nation.
- ≡ And we declare the gospel shall be preached and the word of the Lord shall grow and prevail in this nation.
- ≡ We, the church of Jesus Christ has been set over nations and kingdoms,
- ≡ Therefore, we root out the powers of darkness that has taken root in our nation and we declare the rule and reign of God's kingdom over our nation.
- ≡ This nation is the Lords and all its fullness.
- ≡ Therefore, the will of God is established in our land.
- ≡ We declare the kingdom of this nation has become the kingdom of our God and Jesus shall reign in our land in Jesus name. Amen!

DAY 5: TUESDAY 9TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI 1: PRAYERS FOR THE LEAD PASTOR, PASTOR ALEX ADEGBOYE

EXHORTATION:

The Preacher's Cry - Pray for Us!

"Brethren, pray for us." 1 Thess 5:25

"Men in the pew given to praying for the preacher are like the poles which hold up the wires along which the electric current runs. They are not the power; neither are they the specific agents in making the Word of the Lord effective. But they hold up the wires, along which the divine power runs to the hearts of men." EM Bounds

We have a striking picture of the preacher's need for prayer in Exodus 17, where Israel and Amalek were in battle. Moses stood on top of the hill with the rod of God in his hands, the symbol of power and victory. As long as Moses held up the rod, Israel prevailed, but when he let down his hands, Amalek prevailed. While the contest was almost going in favour of the enemy, Aaron and Hur came to the rescue, and when Moses' hands were heavy, these two men "stayed up his hands, until the going down of the sun". As a result of Aarons and Hur's help, Israel disabled and paralyzed Amalek. The 'staying up of Moses hands' was critical to the outcome of the battle. Moses would have failed in his ministry as the leader of God's people without these men 'striving together by prayers for him!'

This story gives a clear-cut illustration of how a people may sustain their preacher by prayer, and of how victory comes when the people pray for their preacher. The praying congregation is to the preacher what Aaron and Hur were to Moses. Paul's urgent plea for prayer by the church he pastored is a lesson for the modern-day Christian of the importance of prayers by the congregation for their pastor and in our ministry, for our Lead Pastor.

Paul wrote letters to every church, urging them to 'pray for him'. Praying for our Lead Pastor is not simply our duty as the members of this ministry, it is a necessity! Listen to Paul as he more or less 'pleads' for the prayers of the brethren:

- 1) To his brethren at Rome, he wrote: "Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in prayers to God for me." Rom 15:30
- 2) To the Ephesians he says: "..... and (Pray} for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel." Eph 6:19
- 3) To the Colossians he emphasises: "Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds: that I may make it manifest as I ought to speak." Col 4:3

- 4) To the Thessalonians he says sharply: "Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:" 2 Thess 3:1
- 5) Paul calls on the Corinthian Church to help him: "Ye also helping together by prayer for us." This was to be part of their work. 2 Cor 1:11
- 6) Paul indicates that prayer transforms the dangers which come to the preacher: "For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ." It was "through their prayer" he declared these benefits would come to him. And so, it is "through the prayer of a church" that the pastor will be the beneficiary of large spiritual things {the supply of the Spirit}.

If Paul had such a grave need for the prayers of the congregation, then the need to pray for our leaders and in particular for our Lead Pastor cannot be over-emphasized!

God is counting on you and I to make that sacrifice as we pray for our Lead Pastor today and indeed to continue to do so in our private closets.

How do we pray for the Senior Pastor according to the will of God?

We do this effectively by praying in other tongues.

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In this scripture, Paul gave us a very important insight into praying in tongues and its function in the Spirit world. The Holy Spirit is our Helper, Intercessor and Comforter. He is here to help us in every area of our lives and particularly in prayer.

Effective prayer has to be done according to the will of God and by faith. God does not answer or listen to unbelief. Neither does He hear prayers that are not in line with His will (1 John 4:16).

When Paul uses the word help, he is painting the picture of assistance offered to infants not able to support themselves, or to the feeble, staggering and barely able to walk. It means to relieve those whose strength is insufficient to carry their burden alone. The weakness spoken of here is the believers' inability and inefficiency of how to properly and accurately engage a situation in prayer. Our ultimate weakness is 'not knowing' how to properly pray. This is where in praying in tongues, the Holy Spirit gives assistance in that He knows exactly how to pray about the situation. Thus, to pray effectively for the Lead Pastor and his family, we do so by praying in other tongues as the Spirit gives us utterance; and by the help of the Holy Ghost in us, He enables us to pray according to the will of God because He searches the hearts and the minds and knows what is the heart of God for Pastor Alex Adegboye.

During this session, the minister is to ensure he leads the people to pray in tongues for most of the time allotted to prayer.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, 10TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI 1: PRAYER FOR THE LEADERSHIP (RESIDENT PASTORS, APOSTOLIC OVERSIGHT, ASSOCIATE PASTORS, AND ELDERS)

EXHORTATION

ACTS 12:1-7: Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church. And he killed James the brother of John with the sword. And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.) And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people. Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands.

2 THESS 3:1-2: Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you: And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith.

The story in Acts 12 reveals to us that the enemy in trying to bring harm to the church targets the leaders. Herod, a type of Satan suddenly rises up and stretches forth his hand to vex or oppress certain of the church and who did he target? The leadership! He succeeded in killing James and the Jews were pleased with this tragedy. However, this sad event drove the church to fervent prayer which scripture described as unceasing prayers, which we can assume that it was prayer in the spirit or in other tongues.

Paul asked the Thessalonian church to pray for him so that he would be delivered from wicked men. In other words, when the church makes intercession for her leaders, they will be delivered from the oppression of the enemy. The role of the prayers of the church for her leaders cannot be over-emphasized as such prayers are powerful to wrought deliverance for her leaders. When the church prays, the hands of evil stretched out to bring harm to our leaders become paralysed and the evil is overturned and overruled.

It's essential that we pray for WAMI Leaders so that every plan of evil against them and the members of their families will be overturned just like the case of Peter's deliverance which was a consequence of the church making ceaseless prayers for him.

We do not know what to pray for as we ought, but we will be praying in other tongues for them allowing the Holy Spirit to make tremendous power available through our prayers to go to work in the lives of the leadership of WAMI.

How do we pray for the leadership of WAMI according to the will of God?

We do this effectively by praying in other tongues.

Rom 8:26-27: Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

In this scripture, Paul gave us a very important insight into praying in tongues and its function in the Spirit world. The Holy Spirit is our Helper, Intercessor and Comforter. PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYERS FOR WAMI: TAKING TERRITORIES

EXHORTATION:

PSALM 2:8 -9 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession. Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

IS 54:2-3: Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

Deut 1:8 Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give unto them and to their seed after them.

- 3) Because God has commanded us to make disciples of all nations

- 4) Because of the vision of WAMI: the 5Ms which starts with bringing people (nations) into membership in God's family.

We will pray as a ministry for an enlargement of our territory and for our seed to inhabit the desolate (dark) places of the earth. The desolate places are regions that have not been reached with the gospel, as we pray, light begins to shine in such regions and God will open doors for ministry in such regions.

EXHORTATION

The children and the youth are the future of our church and indeed the future of the body of Christ universal. It is upon the shoulders of the youths that God has placed the responsibility of the future and that is why Satan always seeks to abort the purpose of God for their lives by engaging them in all sorts of atrocities or even by premature death. We see many examples in scripture: Moses, Joseph, Jesus. In each of these cases, Satan tried to destroy their lives prematurely because they carried the purpose of God for their generation. They carried the future. Likewise, our children and youths in this church have the call of God upon their lives, they carry a part of God's purpose for the future. We must therefore pray for them so that they will fulfil their purpose in God.

There are several promises in Scripture concerning the seed of the righteous, we will be using these scriptures to pray for our children and the youths in our local assembly.

PRAYER TOPIC: SPEAKING IN TONGUES: GENERATING POWER FOR DOMINION

LUKE 10:19: Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

ACTS 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Exercising dominion requires having the power to do so. Of our own selves, we are weak and unable to do anything. Jesus our Model in His days on earth was heavily dependent on the power of the Holy Spirit in exercising dominion of sickness, diseases, poverty, demonic oppressions, and foul spirits. And when He returned to heaven, the only gift Jesus deemed fit to give all who believe in Him is the Holy Spirit, because being filled with the Holy Spirit is a vital necessity to exert dominion on earth.

The power spoken of in the above scriptures by Jesus is the *Dunamis*; miracle power and explosive power, the explosive power and force generated by the Holy Spirit which was upon Jesus and enabled Him to exercise dominion over the rule of darkness (Acts 10:38)

On the day of Pentecost, the disciples were clothed with power, and they spoke in tongues and became fearless witnesses and workers of God's miracles in the earth.

How is this power generated and released in the life of a believer? By speaking in other tongues. Speaking in tongues is to be endued with power from on high to exercise dominion over the forces of darkness.

Eph 6:18: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

The Holy Spirit in the life of a believer is the power of God potentially residing in him. However, as we exercise ourselves by speaking in other tongues, we generate tremendous power to change situations. We are empowered by the Holy Spirit to exert dominion over our lives, over sicknesses, poverty, demonic oppression, etc. We also receive power and boldness to preach and enforce the kingdom of God on earth as witnesses of the Kingdom.

Praying in other tongues is an aggressive and offensive weapon against the enemy.

As we engage in speaking in other tongues, we generate power within us to exercise dominion over every power of the enemy.

DAY 10: SUNDAY, 14TH JANUARY 2023

PRAYER FOCUS: PERSONAL PRAYERS AND CONFESSION FOR HEALING, HEALTH AND DELIVERANCE

EXHORTATION

GEN 1:1-3: In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Matt 8:16: When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:

Mark 11:22-23: And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Walking in divine health is God's plan for every one of His children. Out of the multitudes that left Egypt, God kept them in a state of health throughout their sojourn in the wilderness in spite of the hardships of their environment. The Lord kept them from the harsh and extreme weather conditions of the wilderness by His Spirit who was a pillar of cloud by day protecting them from the heat and a pillar of fire by night, protecting them from the cold. This is to show us how much God intends to keep us in a state of health.

Psalms 105:37 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.

However, sickness and disease come upon God's people as a consequence of sin and disobedience to God as seen in Deut 28. However, God has also provided a remedy for every sickness and disease that the enemy puts on His children because of sin or ignorance. God's remedy for every sickness is His word and it works just like physical medicine. The word of God goes to the source of every disease and roots it out bringing wholeness.

Right from the very beginning of creation, God exercised dominion over the forces of darkness by speaking into existence His own will. He didn't condemn darkness, but He commanded light to come forth out of darkness. In the New Testament, Jesus cast out devils and healed the sick by His word. In teaching His disciples the principles of faith in Mark 11:23, He taught them that the power to move mountains was in the words that they speak. In other words, as children

of faith, because we believe we speak, and we exert dominion by speaking. Whenever we confess God's word over our lives, the power of God is released into situations facing us and they respond to our words. God commanded light to shine out of darkness, we, having the same spirit of faith also command life out of death; healing and health out of sickness and disease, etc and all situations in our lives that are contrary to the will of God in our lives must respond. When Jesus was confronted with a barren fig tree, He simply spoke to it, but He spoke what He wanted, and the tree responded to the words immediately because of the power released from the spoken word.

Today, we will exercise dominion over sickness, disease, and death by speaking the word of God over our lives. As a result, every foreigner in the form of sickness, disease, barrenness, infirmity, etc will hear the voice of the Lord and come out of their hiding in Jesus name. With the words that we will declare, every demonic oppression will be broken in our lives.

Proverbs declares that the word of God is medicine to our flesh, it goes forth out of our mouth and brings healing to our flesh.

We will be confessing the word of God over our lives tonight and use that to pray. God's word is medicine to our bodies and a healing agent which cleanses our bodies and maintains us in a state of well-being. Every stranger in our bodies will hear the word of God and come out of hiding.

Psalm 18:44-45 As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit them-selves unto me. The strangers shall fade away and be afraid out of their close places.

Matthew 15:13 But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up.

We would put the word of God in our mouth and take it in by praying in tongues over the word spoken. As we do this, The Lord will release His healing anointing into our bodies, and we shall all be made whole.

PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYERS AND CONFESSION; HEALING, HEALTH AND DELIVERANCE

(NOTE: IF YOU CANNOT GO THROUGH ALL THE SCRIPTURES DURING THE ALLOTTED TIME, YOU MAY CONTINUE FROM WHERE YOU STOPPED THE FOLLOWING DAY)

Jesus bore my griefs and carried my sorrows, Jesus was afflicted for my sake and with His stripes, I am healed. The healing Jesus obtained for me on the cross is the cure and remedy for every sickness and disease.

Ps 91:16: With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation, the Lord satisfies me with long life, He satisfies with good health as He shows me His salvation, therefore I confess that I shall live in good health all through this year and I shall not die, I will declare the works of the Lord in sound health.

Ex 23:25-26: And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil. Because I serve the Lord, He blesses my bread and my water, He takes away sickness from my life and that of my household and He fulfils the number of my days. None shall be barren among the members of my household in Jesus name.

Rom 8:11: But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. The same Spirit that raised up Christ from the dead dwells in me and therefore quickens and gives life to my body.

2. JUDGEMENT

The LORD executes righteousness and judgement for all that are oppressed. Pronounce God's judgement upon every sickness/disease oppressing your body or your mind. The sicknesses that hitherto oppressed me shall not be found any longer in my life, sicknesses that oppressed me in the previous years shall not oppress me anymore!

Ex 12:12: For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgement : I am the LORD. Oh God, execute judgement upon every sickness and disease in my body. Pray that the Lord will stretch forth His hand upon your life and judge the enemy. *Zeph 3:19: And I will deal severely with all who have oppressed you. I will save the weak and helpless ones ;(NLT) check KJV*

Pray and command every sickness in your life to dry up, embarrassing illnesses that bring shame to the name of God, resist all such sicknesses and insist that they would not find a place in your life anymore!

Ps 18:44-45: As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me. The strangers shall fade away, and be afraid out of their close places. Let every sickness/disease taking residence in my body hear the voice of God and submit themselves to the word, fade away and come out hiding.

3. THE BLESSING

Gal 3:13-14: Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

The blessing of the Lord is the remedy for every curse, pronounce the blessing of Abraham upon your life which neutralises every generational sickness or infirmity in my life from henceforth. The curse has been broken over my life and the effect of the curse which has manifested in various illnesses has been removed. Therefore, I am free from my family sickness; every disease passed from generation to generation in my family stops to operate anymore for Jesus has redeemed me from the curse! The blessing of Abraham has come upon me through faith in Jesus Christ.

Thank Him for your healing; every part of your body is functioning according to God's divine purpose. *Isa 55:11-13: So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. PRAYER FOCUS: SPEAKING IN TONGUES: STRENGTHENED WITH MIGHT IN THE INNER MAN

EXHORTATION

EPH 3:16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man.

Jude 20: But you, beloved, build yourselves up (founded) on your most holy faith (make progress, rile like an edifice higher and higher), praying in the Holy Spirit

The Weymouth NT puts it this way, "To grant you - in accordance with the wealth of His glorious perfections - to be strengthened by His Spirit with power penetrating to your inmost being."

To strengthen means "to increase in strength and force",

According to 1 Cor 14:2, when you pray in tongues, you are strengthening or fortifying your spirit man with might. The word 'might' is the Greek word "Dunamis", and it means "miracle power and explosive power". The more you pray in tongues, the more explosive power and miraculous power are growing inside of you. Praying in tongues will build up your inner man and if you are strong within, it will keep your body in line. Praying in tongues will make you spiritually fit. The more you pray in the spirit, the more you are increasing in spiritual force within. Just like barbells will build up your arms, praying in tongues will build up your inner man. When you are strong within, the devil is no match for you.

Praying in the Holy Ghost builds supernatural strength in your inner man such that when the world system is going down, you are rising higher and higher like an edifice and as a result, you can exercise dominion over the forces of darkness.

As we pray in tongues, your inner man is supernaturally strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit in you.

DAY 13: WEDNESDAY 17TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: SPEAKING IN OTHER TONGUES: OVERRULE AND OVERTURN THE DEATH ASSIGNMENT OF SATAN AGAINST YOUR LIFE

EXHORTATION:

Acts 12:1-7: Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church. And he killed James the brother of John with the sword. And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.) And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people. Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. And behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands.

To Overrule means to cancel, reverse, rescind, repeal, revoke, retract, disallow, override, veto, quash, overturn, overthrow, annul, nullify, invalidate, negate, and make void'. This is exactly what the early church did when Peter's life was under a death sentence. There was an evil assignment to take away his life. Herod had already beheaded James, as was his plan to vex (harm) certain of the church, and now he proceeded to kill Peter also. It pleased the Jews when James was killed, and this gave Herod boldness to kill Peter also. The Enemy has in the past years brutally taken our members in WAMI and the members of our family. Herod had already signed a death warrant over Peter and the word of Herod was law, it couldn't be changed; Peter was as good as dead but for unceasing prayers by the church.

Acts 12:5...the unceasing prayer refers to a particular kind of prayer which was praying and interceding in tongues. As a result of this prayer, Herod's death assignment was nullified. Praying in tongues reverses death and demonic assignments against your life and your family. This happens because our spirits by the Holy Spirit within us is praying. Such a powerful force is released to annul every evil assignment against our lives.

The effect of such prayers was that Peter was delivered by a mighty hand and the death sentence was passed to Herod.

Praying in other tongues generates tremendous power to annul and destroy every evil machination arrayed against you and your household.

Isaiah 54: 15-17: Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake. Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy. No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.

As you speak in tongues, your spirit by the Holy Spirit within you begins to exercise dominion over every wicked spirit against you. You are set with mighty weapons to destroy the powers of darkness arrayed against you or your household as you pray.

DAY 13: WEDNESDAY 17TH JANUARY 2024

1. PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING: SPEAKING IN OTHER TONGUES: OVERRULE AND OVERTURN THE DEATH ASSIGNMENT OF SATAN AGAINST YOUR LIFE

- ≡ According to the scriptures, this is my heritage as a servant of the Lord,
- ≡ Surely, they shall gather but because such gathering is not of God, they scatter for my sake.
- ≡ No weapon formed against me, and my family shall prosper, and I condemn every tongue that rises against me in judgement in Jesus name.
- ≡ As I pray in other tongues, my spirit by the Holy Spirit within me prays and the Lord by His Spirit frustrates the tokens of the liars, and makes the diviners mad.
- ≡ He turns the evil counsel devised against me backward in Jesus name.
- ≡ As I pray in other tongues, the Lord fights my battles and the kingdom of darkness arrayed against me is brought to destruction in Jesus name.

2. THANKSGIVING

1 John 5:14-15 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Romans 10:12-13: For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

The Holy Spirit has helped us pray effectively for every child and youth of this church according to the will of God, so we are confident that God has heard us because we have prayed according to His will.

Because He heard us, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him. We thank God for every child and youth in this local assembly as the will of God is established in the life of every child and every youth in this church. We give thanks to God for our children and our youths in this church are fulfilling God's purpose in their generation in Jesus name. Give thanks in the Holy Ghost.

3. WAIT ON GOD

Isa 41:1: Keep silence before me, O islands; and let the people renew their strength: let them come near;

Give time for the congregation to wait on God, encourage them to listen to hear from God as prayer is a two-way communication. As our spirits have communed with the father of Spirits, He will respond by speaking back to us. Be still in His presence and He will reveal Himself to our hearts, He will encourage us, give us direction, renew our strength, give comfort, give us revelation about the future, etc.



DAY 14: THURSDAY, 18TH JANUARY 2024

PRAYER FOCUS: SPEAKING IN OTHER TONGUES FOR PERSONAL EDIFICATION

EXHORTATION

1 Cor 14:4: He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself

Jude 20: But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

Luke 1:80: And the child grew, and waxed (became) strong in spirit,

When we speak in tongues, we are able to personally strengthen our spirits. The church today is filled with many Christians who have strong bodies but weak spirits.

Prov 24:8: If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small.

This scripture isn't talking of physical strength but relates to inner strength, strength of spirit. The remedy for our weak impotent Christianity lies in our engaging the life of the Spirit within through speaking in the Spirit. He who speaks in tongues edifies himself....

When we speak in other tongues, we are not strengthening others; we are strengthening and edifying ourselves. Every believer has a personal responsibility to develop a strong spirit, and nothing builds you up as effectively as speaking in other tongues for extended periods of time. Nothing can replace the power of my spirit rising up and bringing my mind, will and emotions and body into alignment with the Holy Spirit as I speak in tongues.

Jude 20: But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost

In this short epistle, Jude warns that in the last days, men will be ruled by their senses and there will be so much evil being paraded as good. What we need these days is strong faith. When we pray in the Holy Ghost, we build up ourselves on our faith. In other words, praying in the Holy Ghost boosts our faith. And as we pray in other tongues, we will rise higher and higher in a world that is going down!

While everything else around us is failing, as we pray in the Holy Ghost, we make progress and rise higher and higher like an edifice. We build strength in our inner man when we engage in this exercise such that we will still be strong and standing even when adversity comes. There is the need for every believer to build inner strength especially in these last days.

The leader should encourage the congregation to make this a regular practice all through the year, the way to keep strong and not to faint; the way to keep ourselves in the love of God is by developing a habit of building inner strength which comes by praying in the Holy Ghost. When we build ourselves up through engaging the power and life of God by speaking in tongues, we will begin to find ourselves walking victoriously in the Spirit. When we have weak spirits, we are powerless to resist the enemy because we are allowing our emotions, appetites, and circumstances to run our lives.

In Luke 1:80, the child, John became strong in spirit! This implies that strong spirits do not come to us by default; we train our spirits to become strong. One of the most effective ways we can build inner strength is by engaging in the spiritual exercise of speaking in other tongues. So many believers think of the message in church as their main source of spiritual fire. The fact is that the sermon isn't our source of fire but it's to serve as a fuel to the fire that's already burning in us. If there's no fire burning in our spirits, the sermons preached will soon die off as quickly as it came. This truth explains why most have forgotten the powerful sermons preached on Sundays by Monday

morning. However, if it serves as a fuel for our fire, the sermons we listen to will last for decades. We must cultivate communion with God through the Holy Spirit in us, the fire baptizer. We must edify ourselves so that when the word is preached to us in church; it will fuel and expand the fire already burning within us.

During this session, there is no "prayer point". We are simply speaking in other tongues as a means to edify and build up ourselves so that our spirits can be strengthened. It's a session of waiting on God simply by engaging in our supernatural language which gives us direct access to God for when we speak in tongues, we are speaking to God directly. When we wait on God in this manner, we exchange our weaknesses for His strength, our inability for His abilities, etc. In other words, there is a divine exchange between us and God such that we take on His strength and we can begin to do things beyond our natural abilities.

Isa 40:30-31: Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Those who should naturally walk will begin to fly like the eagle, they will run and not be weary, they will walk and not faint, that's supernatural and this only comes as we wait upon the Lord.

DAY 14: THURSDAY 18TH JANUARY 2023

PRAYER FOCUS: SPEAKING IN OTHER TONGUES FOR PERSONAL EDIFICATION (LEAD THE CONGREGATION TO PRAY IN THE UNDERSTANDING USING THE CONFESSION BELOW AND THEN PROCEED TO PRAY IN THE HOLY GHOST)

Isa 40:29-31: He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Give thanks for power and for increased strength in the inner man. My spirit is edified and built up and I rise higher and higher like an edifice in Jesus name.

3. WAIT ON THE LORD.

Isa 41:1: Keep silence before me, O islands; and let the people renew their strength: let them come near;
