## DAY 1: FRIDAY, 3RD JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 1: AWAKENING HUNGER

#### **EXHORTATION:**

These first three days of our fasting and prayer focus on rekindling our hunger for God. A hunger for God is a major key to experiencing His manifest presence.

Matt 5:6: Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

God satisfies the man who hungers for Him with Himself! However, material distractions and worldly cares often replace our spiritual appetite, leading us to a place of spiritual dryness and ultimately to a barren and waste land where the enemy takes advantage of us and oppresses us with sins, sicknesses, addictions, poverty, etc. God's presence is a place of divine protection and deliverance from every activity of Satan and a place of satisfaction in God. As believers, our destination and fulfillment lie in God's presence. Through consecration and intimacy, we experience deliverance, strength, and empowerment for exploits.

Q. Are there areas in your life where hunger for God has been replaced by lesser pursuits?

**Focus:** Jesus fulfills our deepest needs as our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption. Our prayer focus is for an awakening of hunger for God in our lives.

#### **Key Scriptures**

**1 Corinthians 1:30:** "It is because of Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness, and redemption."

Matthew 5:6: "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."

**Psalm 27:4:** "One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek Him in His temple."

**Psalm 84:1-12:** A heartfelt expression of longing for God's presence and the blessings of dwelling with Him.

Daniel 11:32b: "But the people who know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits."

Ezekiel 47: God's progressive encounters leading to transformation and revival.

#### **Key Notes from the scriptures:**

- 1. The Promise of Full Deliverance is found in Jesus Christ thus our desire and longing must be for Him. Our journey to spiritual stability begins and ends with Him!
- 2. Desiring God Above All Else: To truly encounter God, our hearts must hunger for Him more than the distractions of the world. This hunger draws us into His presence and transforms our lives.
- 3. The Dwelling Place of the Believer: God's presence is our ultimate home and destination. In His presence, we find strength, consecration, and complete deliverance for exploits.
- 4. Progressive Encounters with God: Like Ezekiel's vision, God invites us to deeper levels of His presence, culminating in revival and empowerment.

## DAY 1: FRIDAY, 3RD JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 1: AWAKENING HUNGER

- → Lord, one thing i desire from you in this new year and that is what i seek you for in the place of prayer
- → That i may dwell in your presence all the days of my life
- → To inquire in your temple and behold your beauty
- → So, Lord, I pray, make me hungry for You; Work in me to desire You above all else
- → Lord, ignite a fresh hunger in my heart to seek You above all else. Let my desires be centred on You
- → Give me an insatiable hunger for spiritual things, that I may grow closer to You each day
- → Take me back to my first love, Lord; Renew my devotion and affection for You
- → Jesus, set my heart ablaze with love for You, renewing my first love
- → Lord, ignite a deep hunger and thirst for your presence in my heart in Jesus' name
- → Work in me to recognize my need for your presence that my heart will long for you alone all my life
- → Restore my hunger for You, Lord. Take me back to the place of undivided devotion
- → As i fellowship with the Holy Spirit by praying in other tongues, I yield to the Holy Spirit to consecrate and purify my desires so that God alone is my hearts desire in Jesus' name.

## DAY 2: SATURDAY, 4TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 2: GROWING INTIMACY THROUGH DESIRE

#### **EXHORTATION:**

These first three days of our fasting and prayer focus on rekindling our hunger for God. A hunger for God is a major key to experiencing His manifest presence. Today, we continue in our cry for hunger for God.

**Psalm 27:4:** One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord (in His presence) all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in his temple.

#### Psalm 84:1-12

<u>Focus:</u> Consider David's longing for God in Psalm 27:4 and Psalm 84:1-12; and ask God to strip away distractions and fill us with a desire to dwell in His presence. A hunger for Gods presence opens the door to intimacy with God where we behold and gaze upon the sweet attractiveness and delightful loveliness of the Lord. It all starts with a deep hunger and thirst for His presence. And when God manifests in our lives, there is deliverance in every area of our lives.

As you pray, remember that God desires to be with you even more than you desire Him. His presence is your ultimate reward, strength, and source of joy. Like David, may your heart cry out:

"My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the Lord; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God." (Psalm 84:2)

May your pursuit of God lead to a life filled with His glory and marked by deep intimacy with Him.

"For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere." (Psalm 84:10)

As you dedicate these days to prayer and seeking God, expect Him to reveal Himself in deeper ways. Hunger for His presence opens the door to intimacy, strength, and transformation. May these days mark a renewed passion for Jesus in your life.

## DAY 2: SATURDAY, 4TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 2: GROWING INTIMACY THROUGH DESIRE

- → Lord, I desire to grow deeper in my intimacy with you as the year begins
- → My heart and my flesh cry out for the living God
- → So, Lord, I ask you to strip away my pride, comfort, and worldly affections and let my heart burn only for You
- → Give me an insatiable hunger for spiritual things, that I may grow closer to You each day
- → Lord, I desire to dwell in Your presence all the days of my life; Fill my heart with an insatiable hunger to seek You continually
- → Father, remove anything in my life—distractions, busyness, or worldly desires—that hinders my intimacy with You
- → Lord, grant me a heart like David's, wholly devoted to You, with one focus: to behold Your beauty and seek You in all I do
- → Father, let my heart and soul long for Your courts. Let the joy of dwelling in Your presence be my greatest delight
- → Restore my passion for You, Lord, as it was in the beginning and let my desire for You surpass all else in my life
- → Lord, cleanse me from the love of material things and worldly cares. Set my affections on things above
- → As I seek You, Lord, let Your presence transform me. Take me from strength to strength as I appear before You in Zion
- → Father, increase my appetite for worship and Your Word. Let them become the foundation of my relationship with You
- → Teach me to value and cherish the privilege of being in Your presence, recognizing that one day with You is better than a thousand elsewhere
- → Lord, let this longing for You not be temporary but a lifelong pursuit. Help me to continually grow in intimacy with You
- → Help me to know You more deeply, Lord, so that I may walk in Your strength and fulfill Your purpose for my life
- → As i continue to pray in other tongues, i yield myself to the Holy Spirit to bring me to a place of deeper intimacy with God in Jesus name.

## DAY 3: SUNDAY, 5TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 3: STRENGTH FOR EXPLOITS AND DEEPER ENCOUNTERS

#### **EXHORTATION:**

These first three days of our fasting and prayer focus on rekindling our hunger for God. A hunger for God is a major key to experiencing His manifest presence. Today, we continue in our cry for hunger for God.

**Ezekiel 47** describes a progressive encounter with God, symbolized by the increasing levels of water flowing from the temple. From ankle-deep to waters deep enough to swim in, this vision portrays a journey into deeper intimacy, empowerment, and fruitfulness in God's presence. As we press into God, we are transformed and equipped to impact the world around us.

**Daniel 11:32** reminds us that strength and exploits are reserved for those who truly know their God. This strength is not merely physical but spiritual, rooted in intimacy with Him. It is this depth of relationship that fuels our ability to carry out His divine mandate.

#### **Key Scriptures**

**Ezekiel 47:1-5**: "And again he measured a thousand and brought me through the waters; the waters were to the ankles, to the knees, to the loins, and then waters to swim in—a river that could not be passed over."

**Daniel 11:32**: "But the people who know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits." **Isaiah 40:29-31**: "He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength...But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength."

#### **Focus for Prayer**

Today, we pray for a deeper encounter with God's presence that brings transformation, empowerment, and consecration. We ask for His supernatural strength to accomplish exploits for His kingdom and seek deliverance from anything that hinders our relationship with Him.

As you seek deeper encounters with God, trust that He is leading you into greater empowerment for His purposes. His river brings life and transformation, and as you allow it to flow through you, you will be equipped for exploits that glorify His name.

When we experience His manifest presence in our lives, we will find deliverance and holiness and possess our inheritance in Christ. Mount Zion is God's dwelling, His presence, thus as we find His presence, we will experience true deliverance.

## DAY 3: SUNDAY, 5TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR HUNGER AND THIRST FOR GOD 3: STRENGTH FOR EXPLOITS AND DEEPER ENCOUNTERS

- → Father, take me deeper into Your presence. Move me from ankle-deep to waters that I cannot pass over and immerse me in Your Spirit
- → Lord, transform my life as I dwell in Your presence. Let the river of Your Spirit bring life, healing, and fruitfulness to every area of my being
- → Empower me with supernatural strength, Lord, to carry out the great exploits You have destined for me
- → Deliver me from anything that keeps me from experiencing the fullness of Your presence—fear, doubt, sin, or distractions
- → Lord, let the river of Your Spirit flow through me, making me fruitful in every area of my life for Your glory
- → Grant me the grace to make an impact in my generation
- → Let Your anointing rest upon me to bring transformation to lives and nations
- → Restore every dry and broken area in my life, and renew my strength and zeal for You
- → Teach me to wait on You, Lord, for renewed strength; Help me to trust in Your timing and rely on Your power
- → Lord, help me to walk in the authority You have given me through intimacy with You
- → Sanctify me, Lord, and set me apart for Your purpose. Let my life be fully consecrated to You for Your glory
- → Breathe upon me, Lord, and restore every dry and lifeless area in me; Fill me with Your life and power
- → Help me to know You more deeply, Lord, so that I may walk in Your strength and fulfill Your purpose for my life
- → Lord, consecrate me and set me apart for Your work. Remove anything in my life that hinders me from fulfilling Your will
- → As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield my life to the Holy Spirit to take me deeper in the river of God's presence in Jesus' name.

## DAY 4: MONDAY, 6TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 1: A HEART FULLY COMMITTED TO PLEASING GOD

#### **EXHORTATION**

As we have focused on cultivating a hunger for God in the past days, we now shift our focus to prayer for a deeper desire to please God. Pleasing God is the key to experiencing His manifest presence. When we seek to please Him, we position ourselves to experience His power, transformation, and deliverance. It is a great privilege and calling to live in a way that pleases God, and it begins with a heart fully committed to Him. In the Scriptures, we see that Jesus Himself always did those things that pleased the Father (John 8:29). In doing so, He experienced the constant presence of God, a presence that empowered Him and brought deliverance. We too can experience this same presence by prioritizing God's will in our lives.

#### **Key Scriptures**

**John 8:29:** "And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him."

John 14:21-23: "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him."

- 2 Thessalonians 3:5: "And may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ."
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## DAY 4: MONDAY, 6TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 1: A HEART FULLY COMMITTED TO PLEASING GOD

- → Father, I commit my heart to You. May my desire to please You be greater than any other desire in my life
- → Lord, align my will with Yours. Help me to seek Your will above all else and to walk in obedience to Your commands
- → I choose to please You above all else, Lord. May my life reflect a heart fully devoted to doing Your will
- → Lord, let my thoughts, actions, and desires be focused on pleasing You, not man or myself
- → Jesus, I desire to love You by obeying Your commandments. Help me to keep Your words close to my heart and walk in them daily
- → Father, as I obey You, may I experience a deeper revelation of Your love and presence in my life
- → Lord, I long for Your manifest presence in my life; Let Your presence be a constant source of empowerment and transformation
- → Jesus, You promised to manifest Yourself to those who love You and obey You. I claim this promise for my life today
- → Lord, I surrender my heart completely to You. May my life be a continuous act of worship that pleases You
- → I give You my ambitions, my plans, and my desires. Mold them according to Your perfect will, that my life may bring glory to Your name
- → Father, direct my heart to align with Your purposes each day. Help me to remain steadfast in my commitment to You
- → May I be sensitive to Your leading and always ready to follow where You lead, trusting that Your way is the best for me
- → Lord, my heart longs for Your presence. Help me to prioritize spending time with You, seeking Your face above all else
- → Let Your presence be the source of my joy and peace. I want to live in constant communion with You
- → Father, as I seek to please You, transform my heart. Remove anything in me that hinders my obedience and devotion to You
- → May the desire to please You shape every aspect of my life, bringing about lasting change and growth in my faith
- → Holy Spirit, ignite in me a deeper desire to please God. Fill me with a passion to seek His will and to honor Him in everything I do
- → Lord, help me to desire nothing more than to please You, knowing that in doing so, I find fulfillment and purpose. May my cry always be, "I have come to do Your will, O Lord."
- → As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to work in me to will and to do of God's good pleasure; Working in me that which brings Him pleasure in Jesus' name.

## DAY 5: TUESDAY, 7TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 2: LIVING IN OBEDIENCE TO PLEASE GOD

#### **EXHORTATION**

We have been praying for a hunger for God which is a key to securing God's manifest presence in our lives. For days 4, 5 and 6 of our fasting and prayer program, we will pray intentionally for a deeper desire to please God which is another key for us to experience Gods manifest presence. Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

From our text, we see that God only manifests Himself to those who please Him and obey Him. The manifestation of Gods presence is promised to those who love Him and desire to please Him above all else.

<u>Prayer Focus:</u> Pleasing God requires obedience to His Word and commands. Obedience is the highest form of love and worship, reflecting our devotion and trust in Him. And when a man lives a life of obedience, God will come to Him and manifest His presence in such a life. That individual comes to Mount Zion and experiences total deliverance and enters into his inheritance.

1 Samuel 15:22: "To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed than the fat of rams."

James 1:22: "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."

**Deuteronomy 5:33**: "Walk in all the ways which the LORD your God has commanded you, that you may live, and that it may go well with you, and that you may prolong your days in the land which you shall possess."

## DAY 5: TUESDAY, 7TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 2: LIVING IN OBEDIENCE TO PLEASE GOD

- → Father, give me a heart of obedience that delights in Your Word and way
- → Lord, instill in me a deep desire to follow Your commandments with joy and dedication
- → Help me to walk in obedience to Your commandments, demonstrating my love for You
- → Enable me to live out Your teachings daily, reflecting Your love in my actions
- → Reveal all areas of disobedience in my life and grant me the grace to repent and align with Your will
- → Expose hidden sins and patterns of disobedience and lead me to genuine repentance
- → Lord, let my actions and decisions be a reflection of my desire to please You
- → Guide my choices so that they honor You and advance Your kingdom
- → Strengthen me to choose Your way over the desires of the flesh or the approval of man
- → Empower me to resist temptations that lead me away from Your path
- → Grant me the perseverance to remain obedient even when faced with challenges and trials
- → Help me to remain steadfast in my commitment to follow You, regardless of circumstances
- → Teach me to see obedience as an act of worship, pleasing to You
- → May my obedience be a fragrant offering that draws Your presence into my life
- → Thank You, Lord, for the blessings that flow from living a life of obedience
- → Help me to recognize and receive the rewards You bestow upon those who honor You with their lives
- → As I continue to pray in the Spirit, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to work in me and strengthen me to obey God all my life in Jesus' name, i yield to the Holy Spirit to guide my steps and empower my obedience.

## DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, 8TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 3: PLEASING GOD ABOVE ALL ELSE

#### **EXHORTATION**

We have been praying for the past 3 days for a hunger for God which is a key to securing Gods manifest presence in our lives. For days 4, 5 and 6 of our fasting and prayer program, we will pray intentionally for a deeper desire to please God which is another key for us to experience Gods manifest presence. From the Scriptures, we see that God's manifest presence is reserved for those who please Him. This presence is not only a source of deliverance but also a place of empowerment and transformation

**John 8:29;** And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

John 14:21-23: He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? ## DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, 8TH JANUARY 2025

## PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER DESIRE TO PLEASE GOD 3: PLEASING GOD ABOVE ALL ELSE

- → Lord, help me to prioritize You in every aspect of my life, seeking Your kingdom and righteousness above all else
- → Grant me the grace to let go of worldly affections and distractions that hinder me from fully pleasing You
- → May my greatest desire be to live a life that glorifies You and reflects Your love to the world
- → Father, empower me to walk worthy of You, being fruitful in every good work and growing in the knowledge of You
- → Let my life be a testimony of Your goodness and an offering of worship that pleases You
- → Lord, refine my desires so that I seek Your approval above the praise and recognition of men
- → Grant me the strength to surrender my personal ambitions, dreams, and desires to align with Your perfect will
- → Father, help me to guard my heart against idols, ensuring that You alone are enthroned in every area of my life
- → Lord, teach me to seek Your presence and guidance in every decision, acknowledging You as the ultimate authority in my life
- → Let my speech, actions, and thoughts consistently bring glory to Your name and reflect my devotion to You
- → Father, help me to love what You love and hate what You hate, aligning my heart with Your desires
- → Grant me the courage to choose obedience to You even when it is uncomfortable or inconvenient
- → Lord, let the pursuit of Your will and pleasure be the foundation of my purpose and priorities
- → Fill me with a holy reverence for You that compels me to live in awe and honor of Your greatness
- → Father, work in me both to will and to do for Your good pleasure, shaping my heart to reflect Your perfect love
- → As i continue to pray in other tongues, i commit to living a life that pleases the Lord in every way as i surrender to the Holy Spirit to refine and align my desires to bring glory to God in Jesus' name.

## DAY 7: THURSDAY, 9TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: FERVENT PRAYER AND WORSHIP 1: PRAYING FERVENTLY TO SEEK GOD'S FACE

#### **EXHORTATION**

The third key to securing the manifest presence of God, which brings deliverance, is fervent prayer and worship. As demonstrated by Paul and Silas in Acts 16:25-26, fervent prayer and worship amid trials lead to the manifest presence of God and supernatural deliverance. Over these three days (days 7,8 and 9), we will focus on seeking God fervently through prayer and offering Him true worship, regardless of our present circumstances. One major way to engage in fervent prayer is by praying in the Holy Ghost for when we do, we are in the spirit in fervent prayer and intercession.

Jeremiah 29:13: "You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart."

James 5:16b: "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."

Psalm 63:1: "O God, You are my God; early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You."

Prayer is a powerful tool to invite the presence of God. Through fervent and heartfelt prayer, we align our spirits with His will and invoke His power to bring deliverance. When we seek God through fervent prayer, we will encounter Him on a personal level. Consider Jacobs dream in Gen 28 where there was access to heaven and God was standing at the top of the ladder with angelic activity to and from heaven. Praying in other tongues carries us from the physical realm into the spiritual realm where we experience encounters with God.

Fervent prayer and worship are powerful keys to encountering God's manifest presence. Just as the chains of Paul and Silas were broken, trust that God will respond to your prayers and worship with deliverance and breakthrough. Let this time be marked by passionate seeking and heartfelt adoration of the One who deserves it all.

"The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth." (Psalm 145:18)

## DAY 7: THURSDAY, 9TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: FERVENT PRAYER AND WORSHIP 1: PRAYING FERVENTLY TO SEEK GOD'S FACE

- → Lord, teach me to pray fervently and with purpose, seeking Your face above all else
- → Stir up my spirit to hunger and thirst for more of You through prayer
- → Let my prayers be filled with faith, passion, and alignment with Your will
- → Father, as I pray, let Your presence fill my heart, breaking every chain and bringing freedom
- → Empower me to stand in the gap for my family, church, and nation through fervent intercession
- → Pour upon me the spirit of grace and supplication that I may pray with intensity and purpose
- → Grant me the discipline to set aside distractions and prioritize time in Your presence through prayer
- → Lord, let my prayers rise like incense before You, drawing me closer to Your heart
- → Break every barrier that hinders my communication with You, and let my prayers ascend boldly to Your throne of grace
- → Strengthen me to persevere in prayer, even when answers are delayed, trusting in Your perfect timing
- → Father, give me a heart of intercession that is burdened for the salvation and deliverance of others
- → Lord, reveal Yourself to me as I pray, and let my intimacy with You deepen with every word spoken in faith
- → Ignite a fire of revival in my life through fervent and persistent prayer

### DAY 8: FRIDAY, 10TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: FERVENT PRAYER AND WORSHIP 2: WORSHIPPING GOD IN SPIRIT AND TRUTH

#### **EXHORTATION**

The third key to securing the manifest presence of God, which brings deliverance, is fervent prayer and worship. As demonstrated by Paul and Silas in Acts 16:25-26, fervent prayer and worship amid trials lead to the manifest presence of God and supernatural deliverance. Over these three days (days 7,8 and 9), we will focus on seeking God fervently through prayer and offering Him true worship, regardless of circumstances. One major way to engage in fervent prayer is by praying in the Holy Ghost for when we do, we are in the spirit in fervent prayer and intercession.

John 4:24: "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

Psalm 22:3: "But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel."

Acts 16:25-26: "But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them."

True worship brings us into the throne room of God, where His presence dwells. Worshiping God in spirit and truth, regardless of circumstances, ushers in His glory and power. (2 Chron 5:13-14). When we give God true worship from our hearts, God will manifest Himself to us.

Fervent prayer and worship are powerful keys to encountering God's manifest presence. Just as the chains of Paul and Silas were broken, trust that God will respond to your prayers and worship with deliverance and breakthrough. Let this time be marked by passionate seeking and heartfelt adoration of the One who deserves it all.

- → May my worship testify of Your power and draw others to encounter Your glory
- → Lord, purify my heart so that my worship is acceptable to You and reflects the love I have for You
- → Teach me to offer the sacrifice of praise continually, regardless of my circumstances, as a testimony of my faith in You
- → Let my worship be a sweet aroma before Your throne, bringing joy to Your heart
- → Help me to make worship a lifestyle, reflecting Your light and love in every area of my life
- → Lord, open my eyes to behold Your beauty and splendor, igniting a deeper passion for worship within me
- → May my worship align with the songs of heaven, declaring Your holiness and greatness
- → Father, draw me closer to You as I worship, allowing me to experience the fullness of Your joy and peace
- → Break every spirit of heaviness, replacing it with the garment of praise as I magnify Your name
- → Empower me to worship with boldness and authenticity, free from fear or the opinions of man

#### **EXHORTATION**

The third key to securing the manifest presence of God, which brings deliverance, is fervent prayer and worship. Over these three days (days 7,8 and 9), we will focus on seeking God fervently through prayer and offering Him true worship, regardless of circumstances. Let this time be marked by passionate seeking and heartfelt adoration of the One who deserves it all.

## **DAY 9: SATURDAY, 11TH JANUARY 2025**

#### PRAYER FOCUS: FERVENT PRAYER AND WORSHIP 3: WORSHIPPING GOD IN AND OUT OF SEASON

- → Lord, help me to worship You in every season, regardless of my circumstances
- → Give me the strength to rejoice in You, even in trials, trusting in Your power to deliver
- → Let my worship be a testimony of my faith in You, confounding the enemy and glorifying Your name
- → Father, let the fire of Your presence consume every obstacle as I lift You high in worship
- → May my heart always say, "Yet will I rejoice in the Lord," even in the face of challenges
- → Teach me to worship You with unwavering faith, knowing that Your plans for me are good and perfect
- → Lord, strengthen me to keep my eyes on You and not on my problems, offering You the sacrifice of praise
- → Fill my heart with songs of hope and gratitude, even in the valleys of life
- → Let my worship be a declaration of Your faithfulness and sovereignty over every situation
- → Help me to worship You with joy, knowing that You work all things together for my good
- → Father, may my worship be a reflection of my trust in Your promises, regardless of what I see or feel
- → Lord, break every spirit of discouragement or doubt, and replace it with the joy of worshiping You
- → Grant me the grace to worship not only with my lips but with my life, in every season
- → Let my worship create an atmosphere for Your divine intervention, bringing peace, healing, and breakthrough
- → Lord, I choose to magnify You above my circumstances, declaring Your greatness in every situation
- → As i continue to pray in other tongues, i worship God in spirit and in truth in Jesus' name.

## DAY 10: SUNDAY, 12TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 1: RECOGNIZING THE DANGER OF PRIDE

#### **EXHORTATION**

Over the past 9 days, we have considered 3 keys that help us to secure the manifest presence of God in our lives, viz:

A hunger and thirst for God; Prayer for a deeper hunger (Days 1, 2 and 3)

A desire to please God and a life of obedience (Days 4, 5 and 6)

Fervent prayer and worship (Days 7, 8 and 9)

For the next 3 days, we will consider poverty of spirit or humility as a key that attracts God's presence in our lives. A humble heart draws God's attention and favour. Through humility, we position ourselves to experience His manifest presence and divine intervention. Over the next three days, we will address the pride in our hearts and ask God to give us a spirit of humility that attracts His presence.

**Is 66:1-2:** Thus saith the Lord, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest? For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the Lord: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.

**Ps 51:17:** The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

1 Peter 5:5: "God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble."

Humility of heart or a broken spirit is a sacrifice that always brings the fire of God, just as Elijahs sacrifice brought down fire from heaven upon the sacrifice. Humility is key to experiencing the manifest presence of God in our lives. Let's all seek the Lord to break us and burn off every pride, stubbornness and rebellion in our souls as we pray for the next 3 days.

In fact, the first beatitude (Matthew 5:3) addresses this fact, that the kingdom of heaven belongs to those who have poverty of spirit. In other words, everything God has is at the possession of the poor in spirit. Pride is an enemy which makes God to resist us, in other words, pride limits us from experiencing His manifest presence. In simple terms, humility is like a magnet that attracts Gods manifest presence towards us. Therefore, our prayer focus for the next three days will deal with our personal pride and arrogance of heart asking God to reset us and bring us to a place of humility.

Pride separates us from God and His presence. It blinds us to our dependence on Him and blocks His blessings. To draw near to God, we must identify and confess areas of pride in our lives.

Humility is the pathway to God's heart and His manifest presence. As you pray and seek His face over these three days, trust that He will refine your heart, breaking every pride and replacing it with a contrite spirit that draws His favor. Like Solomon, may your humble petitions delight the heart of God and unlock His blessings in your life.

"The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit."

(Psalm 34:18)

## DAY 10: SUNDAY, 12TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 1: RECOGNIZING THE DANGER OF PRIDE

- → Lord, I come before You acknowledging that pride can blind me to my need for You
- → Help me identify and confess every area of pride in my life
- → Father, I repent of every attitude, thought, or action that exalts itself above Your Word and will
- → Reveal hidden areas of arrogance in my heart and grant me the grace to surrender them to You
- → Lord, give me a spirit that trembles at Your Word, always yielding to Your will and purpose
- → Create in me a broken and contrite heart, O God, that is pleasing in Your sight

- → Help me to serve selflessly, reflecting Christ's example of humility and sacrifice
- → Break every spirit of superiority, entitlement, or self-righteousness in me
- → Father, I desire to draw near to You. Let my humility be a sacrifice that invites Your presence
- → Pour out Your grace upon me as I humble myself under Your mighty hand
- → Let humility be the foundation of my relationship with You and others
- → Lord, I surrender to Your refining process; Burn off every trace of pride, stubbornness, and rebellion in my soul
- → Mold me into a vessel of honor, purified and set apart for Your glory
- → Let Your manifest presence rest upon me as I walk in humility before You
- → As i continue in prayer, praying in the Holy Spirt, i yield to the inner workings of the Holy Spirit in me as He exposes all forms of pride, stubbornness and rebellion to His light until they completely fade away in my life in Jesus' name.

## DAY 11: MONDAY, 13TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 2: CULTIVATING A SPIRIT OF HUMILITY

#### **EXHORTATION**

Over the past 9 days, we have considered 3 keys that help us to secure the manifest presence of God in our lives, viz:

A hunger and thirst for God; Prayer for a deeper hunger (Days 1, 2 and 3)

A desire to please God and a life of obedience (Days 4, 5 and 6)

Fervent prayer and worship (Days 7, 8 and 9)

For the next 3 days, we will consider poverty of spirit or humility as a key that attracts God's presence in our lives. A humble heart draws God's attention and favour. Through humility, we position ourselves to experience His manifest presence and divine intervention. Over the next three days, we will address the pride in our hearts and ask God to give us a spirit of humility that attracts His presence.

Humility is essential to draw near to God. A contrite heart acknowledges its need for Him, attracting His grace and favor. Like Solomon, we must recognize our inadequacies and seek wisdom and discernment from God.

**Psalm 51:17:** "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and contrite heart—these, O God, You will not despise."

James 4:10: "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up."

A humble heart draws God's attention and favor. When Solomon humbly asked for wisdom, God was pleased and granted his request. The prayer of Solomon shows a heart that is humble before God as He expresses his inadequacies and disqualifications to be chosen as king over Israel. It was this sense of poverty that was the driving force of the prayer for a heart of discernment when God gave him a blank cheque. Others with a heart of pride would have asked for the head of their enemies, long life and more wealth in order to feel a sense of superiority over others.

Humility is the pathway to God's heart and His manifest presence. As you pray and seek His face over these three days, trust that He will refine your heart, breaking every pride and replacing it with a contrite spirit that draws His favor. Like Solomon, may your humble petitions delight the heart of God and unlock His blessings in your life.

Humility is not merely an act but a posture of the heart. It is the recognition of our dependence on God and the willingness to place others above ourselves. As we cultivate a spirit of humility, we position ourselves to reflect Christ's character and attract God's favor.

"The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit." (Psalm 34:18)

**Micah 6:8:** "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."

James 4:6: "But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: 'God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.""

Proverbs 22:4: "By humility and the fear of the Lord are riches and honor and life."

## DAY 11: MONDAY, 13TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 2: CULTIVATING A SPIRIT OF HUMILITY

- → Lord, I surrender my heart to You. Create in me a heart that is broken and contrite, sensitive to Your voice and leading
- → Teach me to walk humbly with You, recognizing that without You, I am nothing
- → Father, like Solomon, I acknowledge my limitations and seek Your wisdom in every decision and area of my life
- → Grant me the humility to depend on You for guidance and strength
- → Lord, help me to follow the example of Christ, who humbled Himself and became a servant to all
- → Teach me to value others above myself and to serve with a heart full of love and compassion
- → Father, replace every trace of pride in me with a hunger for Your presence and a desire to honor You in all I do
- → Let my humility draw Your favor and grace into my life as I depend on You daily
- → Lord, help me to walk humbly with You, fulfilling Your requirements of justice, mercy, and love
- → Let my humility be a testimony of Your work in me, attracting others to Your saving grace
- → As I yield myself to the Holy Spirit, let humility produce the fruit of the Spirit in my life—love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control
- → Father, let my character reflect Your glory as I grow in humility in Jesus' name.

## DAY 12: TUESDAY, 14TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 3: WALKING IN HUMILITY TO ATTRACT GOD'S PRESENCE

#### **EXHORTATION**

Walking in humility daily is the key to sustaining God's manifest presence. It positions us for divine favor, as seen in the lives of David and Elijah. Humility invites God to establish His purpose in our lives.

Humility is the pathway to God's heart and His manifest presence. As you pray and seek His face over these three days, trust that He will refine your heart, breaking every pride and replacing it with a contrite spirit that draws His favor. Like Solomon, may your humble petitions delight the heart of God and unlock His blessings in your life.

"The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart and saves such as have a contrite spirit." (Psalm 34:18)

#### **Key Scriptures**

**Micah 6:8**: "He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?"

**Psalm 34:18**: "The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit."

**2 Chronicles 7:14**: "If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

Walking in humility is a lifestyle that acknowledges God's sovereignty and our dependence on Him. It involves prioritizing His will, serving others selflessly, and reflecting the character of Christ. As we humble ourselves, we attract God's presence and open the door to His blessings and purposes in our lives.

## DAY 12: TUESDAY, 14TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: HUMILITY 3: WALKING IN HUMILITY TO ATTRACT GOD'S PRESENCE

- → Lord, teach me to walk in humility every day, acknowledging my dependence on You in all things
- → Help me to keep my focus on Your greatness, knowing that all I have and come from You
- → Father, may my life reflect the humility of Christ, who gave up His divine privileges and took the form of a servant
- → Help me to lay down my pride and follow His example of obedience and selflessness
- → Lord, help me to prioritize Your will over my desires, submitting every decision to Your guidance
- → Grant me the grace to say "not my will, but Yours be done" in every situation
- → Father, teach me to serve others with love and humility, putting their needs above my own
- → Let my actions reflect the heart of Christ, drawing others closer to You through my service
- → Lord, establish Your purpose in my life as I submit myself to You in humility
- → Let my submission to Your plans bring honor to Your name and fulfillment to my destiny
- → Let my humility bring glory to Your name and serve as a testimony of Your transforming power
- → Use my life to draw others to Your kingdom, showing them the beauty of a surrendered heart
- → Father, as I walk humbly before You, let Your grace and favor abound in my life

## DAY 13: WEDNESDAY, 15TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 1: THE POWER OF SACRIFICE

#### **EXHORTATION**

Offering ourselves completely to God as living sacrifices is a powerful way to experience His glory. In the past 12 days, we've explored hunger for God, a desire to please Him, fervent prayer, humility, and now, we conclude this journey by focusing on *sacrifice and absolute surrender* as key to securing God's manifest presence in our lives.

#### **Key Scriptures**

**Romans 12:1-2**: "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

**Psalm 50:5**: "Gather My saints together unto Me; those that have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice."

Matthew 6:10: "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."

**Matthew 16:24-25:** "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me."

Sacrifice is the act of giving up something valuable to God. When we offer our lives as a sacrifice to God, we invite His fire to consume us. This act of sacrifice places us in the position to receive His glory and experience His presence. As you pray and surrender over the next three days, know that your sacrifice is pleasing to God. He desires to dwell in a surrendered heart, and when you yield to Him fully, He will show you His glory in powerful ways. Just as God is a consuming fire, your life will be set ablaze with His presence, transforming you for His Kingdom purposes. Let this prayer of consecration become a daily act of devotion, continually offering yourself as a living sacrifice to God. May His will be done in you, and may you experience His manifest presence every day!

Sacrifice is a gateway to experiencing the manifest presence of God. The altar of sacrifice invites God's fire, signifying His acceptance and presence. Romans 12:1 urges us to present ourselves as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God. Surrendering all—our ambitions, desires, and will—is the ultimate act of worship, allowing God to work through us for His glory. As we sacrifice and surrender, we position ourselves for divine alignment and the fulfillment of His purpose in our lives.

## DAY 13: WEDNESDAY, 15TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 1: THE POWER OF SACRIFICE

- → Father, I present myself as a living sacrifice to You. Consume me with Your fire and take my life for Your glory
- → Lord, let my heart, mind, and body be wholly dedicated to Your service, holy and acceptable to You
- → I surrender my ambitions, goals, and desires to You, O God. Take them and mold them according to Your perfect will
- → Help me to release anything that competes with Your place in my life, trusting in Your plans for me
- → Lord, let Your Kingdom come in my life. I yield my heart and mind to Your rule, and I invite You to take full control
- → Reign in my life, Lord, and let every aspect of my being reflect Your sovereignty
- → Help me to live a life that is holy and pleasing to You. May my every action reflect Your will and purpose
- → Grant me the grace to resist sin and pursue righteousness, becoming a vessel of honor in Your hands
- → Take my life, O Lord, and use it to accomplish Your will on earth, in Jesus' name
- → Shape me into the image of Christ, that I may fulfill the divine assignments You have ordained for me
- → Lord, as I lay myself on the altar, let Your holy fire fall and refine me. Purge me of anything that does not glorify You
- → May Your presence saturate my life as I offer my all in absolute surrender.
- → Father, empower me to deny myself, take up my cross daily, and follow You wholeheartedly
- → Give me the strength to prioritize Your will above my own, no matter the cost
- → As I continue to pray in other tongues, i yield my desires, ambitions and will to God, asking that Gods holy fire will purge me of anything in my life that does not glorify Him.

## DAY 14: THURSDAY, 16TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 2: ABSOLUTE SURRENDER TO GOD'S WILL

#### **EXHORTATION**

Absolute surrender is yielding everything to God—our plans, desires, and future—allowing Him to work in us and through us. Surrender is not just a one-time event, but a continual process of yielding our will to God's will every day.

As you pray and surrender to Him, know that your sacrifice is pleasing to God. He desires to dwell in a surrendered heart, and when you yield to Him fully, He will show you His glory in powerful ways. Just as God is a consuming fire, your life will be set ablaze with His presence, transforming you for His Kingdom purposes. Let this prayer of consecration become a daily act of devotion, continually offering yourself as a living sacrifice to God. May His will be done in you, and may you experience His manifest presence every day!

#### **Key Scriptures**

**Hebrews 13:20-21**: "Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ."

**Psalm 40:7-8**: "Then said I, Lo, I come: in the volume of the book it is written of me, I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart."

**Luke 22:42**: "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

Psalm 40:8: "I desire to do Your will, my God; Your law is within my heart."

Absolute surrender is the foundation of a life that pleases God and experiences His presence. To surrender means to relinquish control and trust God completely, even when His will diverges from our own plans or desires. Jesus demonstrated this perfectly when He prayed in Gethsemane, "Not My will, but Yours be done" (Luke 22:42). Surrendering to God's will opens the door to His divine purposes being fulfilled in and through us, bringing glory to His name and peace to our hearts.

## DAY 14: THURSDAY, 16TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 2: ABSOLUTE SURRENDER TO GOD'S WILL

- → Lord, I surrender my life to You. Let Your will be done in me and through me as it is in heaven
- → Help me to trust You completely, knowing that Your plans for me are good and perfect
- → Teach me to delight in doing Your will, O God, and help me to walk in obedience to Your commands
- → Fill my heart with joy and peace as I embrace Your will above my own desires
- → I submit all my plans to You, Lord, and ask that You align them with Your greater purpose for my life
- → Guide me in every decision, and redirect my steps when I deviate from Your perfect path
- → I choose to deny my will and take up Your will daily, trusting You to lead me in all things
- → Grant me the courage to follow You, even when it requires sacrifice or goes against my natural inclinations
- → Father, help me to surrender fully and completely, knowing that You are faithful to work in me and bring about Your perfect will
- → Strengthen my faith to trust Your timing, Your ways, and Your outcomes
- → Lord, transform my mind and heart to align with Your desires and purposes
- → May my life be a reflection of Your will, bringing glory to Your name and impacting others for Your kingdom
- → Father, teach me to walk in surrender every day, yielding to the leading of the Holy Spirit
- → Let my life be an ongoing testimony of Your grace, power, and love as I follow You wholeheartedly
- → As i continue to pray in other tongues, i surrender all that i am and all that i have to you Lord in Jesus' name.

## DAY 15: FRIDAY, 17TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 3: CONSECRATION AND DEVOTION

#### **EXHORTATION**

Consecration is setting ourselves apart for God's use. Absolute surrender means not only laying down our will, but also committing ourselves to live a life devoted to Him. This devotion becomes our daily prayer, seeking God's will above our own desires.

#### **Key Scriptures**

Romans 12:1-2: "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

**Matthew 6:33**: "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

**Romans 6:13**: "Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God."

Consecration is the act of setting oneself apart for God's purposes. It is the expression of absolute devotion to His will, where we offer ourselves completely to Him, as living sacrifices. Just as the Apostle Paul encourages us in Romans 12:1 to offer our bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, we must surrender everything to Him. Consecration is more than just a one-time act; it's a daily decision to align our hearts, minds, and actions with His divine purposes. This is a continual offering of our lives as worship to the One who is worthy of all.

## DAY 15: FRIDAY, 17TH JANUARY 2025

#### PRAYER FOCUS: SACRIFICE AND ABSOLUTE SURRENDER 3: CONSECRATION AND DEVOTION

- → Father, I consecrate myself to You. Take my life as a living sacrifice and use me for Your glory

- → Father, help me to walk in daily devotion to You, staying focused on Your kingdom and Your righteousness
- → Let me find joy and fulfillment in living according to Your will, seeking first Your kingdom above all else
- → Lord, help me to fulfill Your purpose for my life. I want to bring honor to You and live out Your calling for me
- → Guide me in every step I take, and let my life be a testimony of Your goodness and faithfulness
- → Father, give me a heart that is wholly devoted to You. Remove every distraction and hindrance that keeps me from fully surrendering to Your will
- → May my devotion to You be my greatest desire, above all other things
- → Lord, I desire to live for Your glory alone. Help me to reflect Your love and grace in all my actions and decisions
- → May my life be a reflection of Your glory, drawing others to You through my example of surrender and devotion
- → As i continue to pray in other tongues, i yield to the Holy Spirit to align my will with God's and guide me in fulfilling His divine calling for my life in Jesus' name.
