DAY 1: FRIDAY, 3RD JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: A CRY FOR PERSONAL REVIVAL

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, I ACKNOWLEDGE MY SPIRITUAL NEED; REVIVE MY SOUL ACCORDING TO YOUR WORD, BREATHE LIFE INTO EVERY DRY PLACE IN ME, AND RESTORE MY PASSION, HUNGER, AND INTIMACY WITH YOU.*

Text: "My soul cleaves to the dust; revive me according to Your word." — Psalm 119:25

EXHORTATION

Every move of God begins in the hearts of individuals who are hungry for Him. Revival is not first a church-wide event; it is a personal awakening. When God wants to revive a people, He first stirs the heart of one man, one woman, one youth, one elder. Today, as we begin this 15-day journey, we present ourselves before the Lord and cry out for a personal encounter. We ask Him to break the hardness of our hearts, remove spiritual dryness, rekindle hunger, and awaken our spirit to seek Him like never before. Personal revival is the seed from which corporate revival grows. As we pray today, may the Lord ignite fresh fire on your altar.

Psalm 119:25 gives a picture of the honest cry of a believer who recognizes his true spiritual condition. This is the voice of a child of God who has become aware of spiritual decline and desperately needs divine intervention. The Psalmist declares, "My soul cleaves to the dust." This speaks of a heart weighed down, a spirit weakened, and affections pulled toward things that do not please God.

The word cleaves is strong—it implies attachment, union, and attraction. The Psalmist admits that his soul is dangerously drawn toward dust: toward weakness, emptiness, carnality, and death. He does not pretend, defend himself, or shift blame. He comes honestly before God and cries for revival.

This teaches us that revival begins with humility and honesty. As Scripture declares in 2 Chronicles 7:14, revival begins when God's people humble themselves. James 4:6 also reminds us that God gives more grace to the humble. There can be no revival where there is pride, denial, or self-confidence.

The Psalmist understood that this condition required a miracle. And so do we. Revival is not about your neighbour—it is personal. YOU must cry. YOU must acknowledge your need. Like the Psalmist, every believer must say, "Lord, this is my condition—revive me."

The Psalmist does not base his cry on emotion or effort, but on God's Word:
"Revive me according to Your word."

According to God's promises.

According to His covenant.

According to His unchanging will to restore His people.

As we begin this 15-day fast, let this be the cry from every heart:

"Lord, I am not where I should be. I need You. Revive me now."

DAY 1: FRIDAY, 3RD JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: A CRY FOR PERSONAL REVIVAL

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You at the beginning of this 15-day fast with humility, brokenness, and holy expectation. Lord, I acknowledge that without You, I can do nothing.
- ▷ Father, I cry out: revive me again! Revive my soul, revive my mind, revive my spirit. Let every place where I have grown weak be strengthened by Your Spirit. Let every part of me that has fallen asleep be awakened by Your breath. I surrender afresh, O Lord. I give You my heart, my will, my desires, my habits, my thoughts—take over once again.
- ▷ Lord, restore my hunger for Your Word. Restore my passion for prayer. Restore my desire for holiness. Restore my longing for fellowship with the Holy Spirit. Draw me close to You again. Let the fire that once burned in me burn again; stronger and deeper!
- ▷ Father, any form of lukewarmness in my life, let it be broken today. Any complacency, lethargy, or spiritual laziness, let Your fire consume it. Any distraction that has taken my eyes off You, remove it from my path. Anything I have allowed to take Your place in my heart, Lord, uproot it, tear it down, and take Your rightful place in my life.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, breathe on me. Awaken every dormant gift, every sleeping passion, every buried calling. Stir a fresh longing in me for the presence of God. Make my heart tender again. Let me weep again over sin. Let me hunger again for righteousness. Let me thirst again for the living God.
- ▷ Lord, I ask that you cleanse my heart and purify my motives. Let my love for You be genuine and deep. Father, let the revival I seek begin within me. Let it begin in my heart. Let it begin in my soul.
- ▷ Lord, let the revival begin with me now!
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, I receive help from the Holy Spirit, to cry out to God for personal revival in Jesus' name.

DAY 2: SATURDAY, 4TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: CONSECRATION AND REPENTANCE

PRAYER POINT: *HOLY SPIRIT, WORK DEEPLY IN MY HEART TO BRING GENUINE CONVICTION AND TRUE REPENTANCE; GIVE ME A BROKEN AND CONTRITE HEART, CLEANSE ME FROM ALL SIN, AND REVIVE ME THROUGH HUMILITY AND OBEDIENCE.*

Text: Create in me a clean heart, O God; And renew a right spirit within me – Ps 51:10

EXHORTATION

Isaiah 57:15; Joel 2:12–13; 2 Corinthians 7:10

Revival is never accidental. It is always the response of a holy God to a broken and contrite heart. Scripture consistently teaches that God revives the humble, not the proud; the repentant, not the defensive; the broken, not the self-sufficient.

Isaiah 57:15 declares that God dwells with those who are of a contrite and humble spirit “to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.” This means revival is not merely something God does around us — it is something He does within us, beginning with repentance.

Psalms 51 reveals the heart of a man who had lost spiritual ground and knew that only God’s mercy could restore him. David understood that sacrifice without repentance was meaningless. He cried, “The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, Thou wilt not despise.” True repentance is not sorrow over consequences, but grief over sin itself.

However, Scripture also teaches us something critical: true repentance is not self-generated. It is the work of the Holy Spirit. According to 2 Corinthians 7:10, “godly sorrow worketh repentance unto salvation.” This godly sorrow is not human regret; it is Spirit-produced conviction that leads to genuine turning of the heart.

This is why religious activity alone cannot produce revival. People can cry, fast, and confess outwardly, yet remain unchanged inwardly. Joel 2:12–13 warns us that repentance must go beyond outward expressions— “Rend your heart, and not your garments.” Only the Holy Spirit can pierce the heart deeply enough to expose sin honestly and produce lasting transformation.

Without the work of the Holy Spirit, repentance becomes shallow, Confession becomes mechanical and Change becomes temporary. But when the Spirit convicts, Hearts are broken and Revival begins.

As we approach God today, our prayer is not simply, “Lord, forgive us,” but “Holy Spirit, work in our hearts.” We ask Him to shine His light into hidden places, to awaken our conscience, and to lead us into genuine repentance.

Where there is true repentance, revival will always follow.

God revives the contrite heart and that heart condition is the work of the Holy Spirit.

DAY 2: SATURDAY, 4TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: CONSECRATION AND REPENTANCE

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ My dear heavenly Father, I come before You today with humility and reverence. I acknowledge that You are holy, and that without holiness no one can stand in Your presence. I confess that I need You, not only for forgiveness, but for true inner transformation.
- ▷ Lord, I recognize that genuine repentance cannot be produced by my own effort. I ask for the working of the Holy Spirit in my heart. Holy Spirit, shine Your light upon me. Search me deeply. Convict me of sin, righteousness, and judgment. Expose every hidden place, every compromise, every wrong affection that displeases God.
- ▷ Father, give me a broken and contrite heart. Remove pride, self-justification, and resistance to truth from within me. Let godly sorrow rise in my heart, not sorrow over consequences, but sorrow that leads to genuine repentance and true turning toward You.
- ▷ Lord, I do not want outward expressions without inward change. I rend my heart and not my garments. Cleanse me thoroughly. Wash me from all iniquity. Purify my motives. Sanctify my thoughts. Restore truth and integrity in my inner being.
- ▷ Father, according to Your Word, revive my spirit and revive my heart as I humble myself before You. Let the fruit of repentance be evident in obedience, humility, and renewed devotion to You. Let sin lose its grip over my life, and let grace abound.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, lead me into repentance that produces lasting transformation and revival. Remove every hardness of heart. Awaken my conscience. Restore the fear of the Lord within me. Let holiness become my desire and obedience my delight.
- ▷ I surrender myself fully to You today. Do Your work in me. Change me from within. Let this season of repentance become the doorway to genuine revival in my life.
- ▷ I thank You, Father, because You are faithful. I receive cleansing, renewal, and revival through Your mercy and grace.
- ▷ As i continue to pray in other tongues, i surrender myself to the workings of the Holy Spirit to renew a right spirit within me in Jesus name.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, 5TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR REVIVAL FOR THE NATION

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, WE ARE STANDING IN THE GAP FOR NATIONAL REVIVAL. LORD, HAVE MERCY UPON OUR NATION; AS WE HUMBLE OURSELVES AND TURN TO YOU, FORGIVE OUR SINS, HEAL OUR LAND, AND POUR OUT YOUR SPIRIT TO BRING NATIONAL REVIVAL.*

Texts:

"If My people who are called by My name shall humble themselves..." — 2 Chronicles 7:14

"I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge and stand in the gap before Me for the land..." — Ezekiel 22:30

EXHORTATION

National revival has never been accidental; it has always been the response of a merciful God to sincere intercession. Scripture consistently reveals a powerful truth: one praying man can alter the destiny of an entire nation.

In 2 Chronicles 7:14, God reveals His divine order for national healing. Revival does not begin in political systems or public reforms—it begins with God's people humbling themselves, praying, seeking His face, and turning from wicked ways. Only then does God promise to hear from heaven, forgive sin, and heal the land. This means that the spiritual condition of a nation is directly connected to the spiritual posture of God's people.

In Ezekiel 22:30, God makes a sobering declaration: "I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge and stand in the gap before Me for the land..." God was not looking for a crowd, a movement, or an institution, He was looking for one man willing to stand in the gap through prayer and intercession. Tragically, He found none.

Throughout Scripture, however, we see moments where God did find that man and nations were changed.

Moses stood in the gap when Israel provoked God through idolatry. As Moses interceded, Scripture records that "the LORD repented of the evil which He thought to do unto His people" (Exodus 32:9–14). Psalm 106:23 later confirms this, declaring that Moses "stood before Him in the breach, to turn away His wrath." One man's prayer spared a nation from destruction.

Daniel, while in captivity, understood from the Scriptures that the appointed time for Israel's restoration was near. He set his face to seek the Lord with fasting and prayer (Daniel 9:2–3). As he prayed, heaven responded immediately, and divine revelation concerning national restoration was released (Daniel 9:20–23). One man's intercession shifted the course of national captivity.

Elijah prayed in a time of deep national apostasy. On Mount Carmel, he cried out to God, saying, "Hear me, O LORD, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again" (1 Kings 18:36–39). Fire fell from heaven, and a nation turned back to God. James later affirms that Elijah was a man like us, yet his prayer changed national history (James 5:17–18).

Nehemiah, upon hearing of Jerusalem's broken walls, wept, fasted, and prayed for days (Nehemiah 1:3–11). His prayer opened doors before kings, and through his leadership, the nation was rebuilt (Nehemiah 2:4–8). One man's burden birthed national restoration.

These accounts reveal a divine pattern: revival does not begin when everyone prays—it begins when someone prays. God is still searching for men and women who will stand in the gap, not with criticism or complaint, but with repentance and intercession.

The condition of our nation today demands such prayers. Sin abounds, righteousness is mocked, violence increases, and moral foundations are shaken. Yet God's eyes still roam the earth, looking for those who will respond.

The question is no longer, "Can God revive the nation?" The real question is, "Will I stand in the gap?"

Today's prayer is deeply personal. Each believer is invited to become that one voice before God, crying out for mercy, healing, and revival in the land.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, 5TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: Prayer for Revival for the Nation

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today carrying the burden of my nation upon my heart. I acknowledge that You are righteous and just in all Your ways. I confess that as a nation, we have sinned against You. We have departed from Your truth, rejected Your ways, and embraced unrighteousness. Lord, have mercy upon our land.
- ▷ I humble myself before You, O God. I pray. I seek Your face. I turn away from every known sin in my life, knowing that revival must begin with me. According to Your Word, hear from heaven, forgive our sins, and heal our land.
- ▷ Lord, You said in Your Word that You sought for a man to stand in the gap for the land. Today, I answer that call. I stand in the gap before You on behalf of my nation. I refuse to be silent. I refuse to be indifferent. I lift my voice in repentance and intercession.
- ▷ Father, forgive the sins of our land, corruption, injustice, immorality, bloodshed, pride, rebellion, and the rejection of truth. Forgive our leaders. Forgive us for calling evil good and good evil. Let the blood of Jesus speak mercy over our nation.
- ▷ Lord, heal our land. Heal our broken systems. Heal our economy. Heal our leadership. Heal our families. Heal our schools and communities. Where there is darkness, let Your light shine. Where there is violence, release peace. Where there is confusion, release wisdom. Where there is despair, release hope.
- ▷ Lord, pour out Your Spirit upon this nation. Let revival fire sweep across cities and villages. Let hearts turn back to You. Let churches awaken. Let prayer altars be rebuilt. Let righteousness exalt this land again.
- ▷ As You responded to the prayer of one man in Scripture, respond again today. Let my prayer join the cries of faithful intercessors across this nation. Let mercy triumph over judgment. Let revival visit our land.
- ▷ I thank You, Lord, because You hear the cry of the humble. I believe You are healing our nation. I believe You are raising intercessors. I believe revival will come.
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to make intercession through me for this nation in Jesus' name.

DAY 4: MONDAY, 6TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR REVIVAL OF THE YOUTH OF THE NATION

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, REVIVE THE YOUTHS OF OUR NATION! DELIVER THEM FROM CORRUPTION, AWAKEN THEIR SPIRITS, AND RAISE YOUR END-TIME ARMY!*

Text: Joel 2:28–29

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy... your young men shall see visions...”

EXHORTATION

Scripture makes it clear that when God moves in revival, the youth are never on the sidelines. In Joel 2:28–29, God announces an outpouring of His Spirit that marks the last days, and significantly, this outpouring is directed first toward sons, daughters, young men, servants, and handmaidens. Revival begins with the young.

Youth are bubbling with energy, passion, strength, creativity, and vision. That energy is never neutral. If it is not captured by God, it will inevitably be exploited by the enemy. Satan aggressively targets young people because he understands what God has placed within them. But God also has a divine agenda: the youth are His strategy for national and global revival.

Throughout Scripture, God consistently entrusted world-changing assignments to young people.

Mary was a young teenager when God chose her to conceive and birth the Saviour of the world (Luke 1:26–38). God did not wait for age; He looked for availability and purity of heart. The apostles of Jesus were mostly young men—ordinary, untrained, yet Spirit-filled—and through them God turned the world upside down (Acts 4:13; Acts 17:6).

John later writes, “I write unto you, young men, because ye are strong” (1 John 2:14). Youth possess strength for spiritual warfare. They can be instruments of righteousness or tools in Satan’s kingdom, depending on who captures their hearts.

Joel’s prophecy shows us that the final harvest will be carried by a Spirit-filled youth army, young men and women who see visions, prophesy, pray, preach, and burn with holy passion. National revival is impossible without youth revival.

As we pray today, our cry is not merely for moral reform among young people, but for spiritual baptism, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit that transforms youths into warriors, evangelists, intercessors, missionaries, and reformers. We cry for a generation that will not be lost to lust, vanity, and rebellion, but raised as God’s end-time army to bring in the final harvest.

DAY 4: MONDAY, 6TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PRAYER FOR REVIVAL OF THE YOUTH OF THE NATION

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today carrying the burden of the youth of this nation and of our assembly. You are the God of generations, and You have declared that in the last days You will pour out Your Spirit upon sons and daughters, upon young men and young women. Lord, let Your Word be fulfilled in our time.
- ▷ Father, I cry out for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our youth. Pour out Your Spirit upon them afresh. Where their energy has been wasted on sin, redirect it toward righteousness. Where their passion has been captured by the world, reclaim their hearts for Your kingdom.
- ▷ Lord, deliver our youth from immorality, lust, addiction, rebellion, confusion, and debauchery. Break the power of pornography, substance abuse, godlessness, and destructive influences. Rescue them from being tools in the hands of the enemy, and consecrate them as instruments of righteousness.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, baptize our young men and women with fire. Let them see visions. Let them prophesy. Let them burn with passion for Jesus. Awaken prayer altars among them. Stir hunger for the Word. Ignite boldness for the gospel. Let them love holiness and pursue purity.
- ▷ Father, raise among them evangelists, missionaries, intercessors, prophets, teachers, and reformers. Raise campus revivalists. Raise prayer warriors. Raise worshippers. Raise voices that will proclaim Christ without shame. Make them arrows in Your hand and flames in Your kingdom.
- ▷ Lord, just as You used Mary, a young woman, to birth salvation to the world, use this generation to carry and reveal Christ to the nations. Just as You used young apostles to shake their world, use our youths to bring revival to this nation and beyond.
- ▷ I cry out for a holy separation in their hearts. Remove ungodly friendships. Silence destructive voices. Connect them to godly mentors, spiritual fathers and mothers, and communities that will strengthen their faith.
- ▷ Father, let the youth of this nation rise as Your end-time army. Use them to bring in the final harvest before the return of Christ.
- ▷ Thank You, Lord, because You are raising a generation that seeks Your face. I receive this revival for our youth by faith.
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to make intercession for the youths in our nation according to the will of God in Jesus' name.

DAY 5: TUESDAY, 7TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: REVIVAL OF THE BODY OF CHRIST NATIONALLY

PRAYER POINT: *REVIVE YOUR CHURCH IN HOLINESS AND POWER, O LORD. LORD, REVIVE THE BODY OF CHRIST IN OUR NATION; RESTORE HOLINESS, UNITY, PRAYER, AND SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY TO YOUR CHURCH, CLEANSE US FROM COMPROMISE, RENEW OUR FIRST LOVE, AND MAKE THE CHURCH A POWERFUL LIGHT AND WITNESS IN THE LAND.*

Texts:

Hebrews 12:14 – “Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.”

1 Peter 4:17 – “For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God.”

Revelation 2:4-5 – “Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.”

EXHORTATION

National revival is impossible without a revived Church. Before God heals the land, He first purifies His people. Scripture is clear: judgment begins in the house of God. If the Church is weak, compromised, prayerless, and worldly, the nation will reflect that weakness.

The greatest need of the Body of Christ today is not relevance, popularity, or expansion—it is holiness and spiritual life. Holiness is not optional; it is foundational. Hebrews 12:14 declares that without holiness, no one will see the Lord. Where holiness is absent, spiritual authority is lost. Where holiness is neglected, revival cannot be sustained.

In Revelation 2, Jesus speaks to a church that was active, doctrinally sound, and hardworking yet spiritually declining. Their greatest problem was not persecution or false doctrine, but loss of first love. This shows us that a church can be busy and still be spiritually dead.

Across the nation, the Church has often exchanged the fear of God for the fear of men, depth for display, power for performance, and purity for popularity. Yet God is calling His Church back—not to condemnation, but to repentance and restoration.

True revival begins when the Church returns to the fear of the Lord, the altar of prayer, the authority of the Word, and true worship.

As we pray today, we are praying for the Church. We cry for a purified Church, a revived Church, a praying Church, a holy Church, one that can once again carry God’s glory and influence the nation.

DAY 5: TUESDAY, 7TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: REVIVAL OF THE BODY OF CHRIST NATIONALLY

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today burdened for the Body of Christ in this nation. Lord, I stand in the gap and cry out for revival in Your Church.
- ▷ Father, forgive us where we have compromised holiness. Forgive us where we have tolerated sin, celebrated carnality, and excused disobedience. Forgive us where we have chosen popularity over purity, applause over obedience, and activity over intimacy. Cleanse Your Church, O God.
- ▷ I ask that You restore the fear of the Lord to the Body of Christ. Let reverence return to our pulpits, our altars, our worship, and our leadership. Purify our motives. Sanctify our methods. Let holiness and a passion for souls become our pursuit again.
- ▷ Lord, revive Your Church. Where there is spiritual dryness, release fresh fire. Where there is prayerlessness, restore the spirit of supplication. Where there is routine, release divine encounter. Where there is division, release unity in truth and love.
- ▷ Father, restore first love to Your Church. Bring us back to the simplicity and passion of devotion to Christ. Rekindle hunger for Your Word. Rekindle zeal for prayer. Rekindle passion for souls. Rekindle love for righteousness.
- ▷ Lord, purify the leadership of the Church across this nation. Strengthen pastors, apostles, prophets, evangelists, teachers, and shepherds. Let integrity and humility mark their lives.
- ▷ I pray that You will raise a praying Church—watchmen on the walls, intercessors in the gap, believers who will not be silent. Let prayer altars be rebuilt in churches and homes. Let the Church regain her spiritual authority.
- ▷ Father, make Your Church a true light in this nation. Let signs, wonders, salvation, and transformation flow again. Let the Church not mirror the world, but confront it with truth and love. Let revival begin in the Church and spread into the nation.

EXHORTATION

Evangelism is not an optional activity of the Church; it is the very heartbeat of God. Heaven rejoices over one sinner who repents, and Christ Himself declared that He came “to seek and to save that which was lost.” Any church that loses its burden for souls loses alignment with God’s eternal agenda.

At Word Alive Ministries International, our Mission Statement Number One is clear: “To bring people into membership in God’s family.” This means that soul winning is not the assignment of a department, a few gifted individuals, or church leaders alone, it is the responsibility of every member of the church.

Revival for evangelism begins when God places His burden for souls into the hearts of His people. Until hearts are stirred, mouths will remain silent. Until compassion is restored, the Church will remain comfortable while souls perish. Jesus looked at the multitudes and was moved with compassion because they were weary and scattered. Revival restores that compassion.

The Great Commission in Matthew 28 is not a suggestion; it is a command. Jesus entrusted the task of global soul winning to ordinary believers empowered by the Holy Spirit. The early church did not grow because of sophisticated strategies, but because believers were on fire, bold, and deeply burdened for the lost.

Many believers today love church but have lost passion for souls. We attend services faithfully but rarely share Christ intentionally. We celebrate testimonies but hesitate to witness. Yet revival demands that every member becomes a soul winner.

Evangelism is not about eloquence; it is about obedience. It is not about perfection; it is about compassion. When revival truly touches a church, evangelism stops being an event and becomes a lifestyle.

As we pray today, our cry is that every member of WAMI will carry God’s heart for the lost; Feel the pain of unsaved souls; Share Christ boldly and lovingly; and Fulfil the Great Commission personally.

A revived church is a soul-winning church. A revived believer is a witness wherever they go.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, 8TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: REVIVAL FOR EVANGELISM AND SOUL WINNING

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today asking for a fresh burden for souls. I acknowledge that You love the lost and that You desire all men to be saved. Lord, forgive me where I have become comfortable, silent, or indifferent toward those who do not know You.
- ▷ Father, place Your burden for souls in my heart. Let me feel what You feel when souls are lost. Break my heart for what breaks Yours. Remove fear, complacency, and excuses from my life. Deliver me from spiritual indifference. Let compassion rise within me again.
- ▷ Lord, revive my passion for evangelism. Restore boldness in my spirit. Let the fire of the Holy Spirit burn within me so that I cannot remain silent about Jesus. Give me wisdom to speak. Give me courage to act. Give me love that reaches beyond my comfort zone.
- ▷ Father, I commit myself to fulfilling the Great Commission. Use me to bring people into membership in God's family. Open my eyes to see opportunities to witness. Open my mouth to speak life. Open hearts around me to receive the gospel.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, empower me to be an effective witness. Let my life reflect Christ. Let my words carry grace and truth. Let signs, conviction, and divine encounters accompany the sharing of the gospel.

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, STRENGTHEN AND REVIVE OUR GLOBAL LEAD PASTOR; GRANT HIM A HEARING AND OBEDIENT HEART, FRESH WISDOM, DIVINE STRENGTH, AND SUSTAINED FIRE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, PRESERVE HIM IN HUMILITY AND INTEGRITY, UPHOLD HIS FAMILY, AND EMPOWER HIM TO LEAD ACCORDING TO YOUR PERFECT WILL.*

Texts:

1 Kings 3:9 – “Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad...”

Exodus 17:8–13 – “...when Moses held up his hand, Israel prevailed... but Moses’ hands were heavy...”

EXHORTATION

Leadership in God’s kingdom is not sustained by intellect, experience, or popularity—it is sustained by divine guidance and divine strength. Few prayers in Scripture reveal this truth as clearly as Solomon’s prayer in 1 Kings 3:9. When given the opportunity to ask for anything, Solomon did not ask for wealth, longevity, or victory over enemies. He asked for a hearing heart.

A hearing heart is more than intelligence. It is the spiritual capacity to discern God’s voice amid countless human voices. Leaders are constantly bombarded with opinions, ideas, innovations, advice, criticism, and suggestions—from well-meaning people and from opposing spirits alike. The danger is not the abundance of counsel; the danger is hearing wrongly.

When a leader hears incorrectly and makes decisions outside God’s will, the consequences can be devastating—not only to the leader, but to the people entrusted to him. Solomon understood this weight when he prayed, “that I may discern between good and evil, and govern this people aright.” Without discernment, leadership becomes dangerous.

But wisdom alone is not enough. Even the most anointed leaders can grow weary. Exodus 17 presents a sobering picture: as long as Moses’ hands were lifted, Israel prevailed. When weariness caused his hands to fall, the enemy gained ground. Moses did not fail because of sin, but because of human limitation.

This is where the responsibility of the Church comes in. Aaron and Hur stood beside Moses and held up his hands until sunset. This teaches us that leaders are not meant to stand alone. A praying Church sustains the victory of its leadership.

Today, we pray for two critical needs in leadership:

A hearing, obedient heart — to discern God’s voice and walk in His will.

Divine strength and spiritual renewal — to resist weariness, burnout, and lukewarmness.

We do not criticize leaders; we cover them.

We do not compete with leaders; we support them.

We stand as Aaron and Hur, holding up their hands until victory is secured.

DAY 7: THURSDAY, 9TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI LEADERSHIP: PRAYER FOR THE GLOBAL LEAD PASTOR

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today lifting up the leaders You have placed over Your people. I acknowledge that leadership is a divine calling and a heavy responsibility. Lord, I pray especially for a hearing heart for Your servant, according to the prayer of Solomon.
- ▷ Father, give him a heart that hears You clearly. Amidst the many voices that surround him; the counsel of men, opinions, ideas, pressures, and expectations, let Your voice rise above all others. Grant him discernment to distinguish between good and evil. Let him not hear wrongly or decide outside Your will.
- ▷ Lord, I pray that his heart will not only hear, but obey. Let his spirit remain sensitive to Your leading. Guard him from confusion, distraction, and self-reliance. Keep him aligned with Your purposes at all times.
- ▷ Father, I also pray for strength. Leadership is demanding, and weariness can set in. Just as Moses' hands grew heavy on the hill, I ask that You renew the strength of Your servant. Let him not grow tired in well-doing. Let discouragement not overwhelm him. Let the weight of responsibility not crush his spirit.
- ▷ Today, I take my place as Aaron and Hur. I stand in prayer to uphold his hands. I commit to supporting him spiritually, that the rod of authority You placed in his hands will remain lifted. As long as his hands are upheld, let victory continue in the church.
- ▷ Lord, revive his spirit afresh. Rekindle the fire of his calling. Let him never succumb to lukewarmness, routine, or spiritual dryness. Restore joy in ministry. Restore passion for Your presence. Restore strength for prayer, the Word, and obedience.
- ▷ Father, preserve his heart in humility. Protect him from pride and compromise. Surround him with godly counsel and faithful helpers. Let Your grace abound toward him daily.
- ▷ Thank You, Lord, because You are sustaining Your servant. I believe You are granting him a hearing heart, renewed strength, and fresh fire.
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, my spirit by the Holy spirit within me makes intercession for Pastor Alex Adegboye according to the will of God in Jesus' name.

DAY 8: FRIDAY, 10TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI LEADERSHIP: PRAYER FOR THE APOSTOLIC OVERSIGHTS AND RESIDENT PASTORS

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, STRENGTHEN AND REVIVE THE RESIDENT PASTORS AND APOSTOLIC OVERSIGHT OF WORD ALIVE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL; CLOTHE THEM WITH THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM, UNDERSTANDING, COUNSEL, AND MIGHT, IGNITE THEIR HEARTS WITH FRESH FIRE, UPHOLD THEIR FAMILIES, AND PERFECT THEM IN EVERY GOOD WORK TO FAITHFULLY CARRY AND ACCOMPLISH YOUR VISION.*

Texts:

Isaiah 11:1–3; Hebrews 13:21; Isaiah 40:31

EXHORTATION

Leadership in the house of God is both a privilege and a weighty responsibility. Those who serve as resident pastors and provide apostolic oversight are not merely administrators or organizers; they are carriers of vision, stewards of divine revelation, and spiritual midwives entrusted with birthing God's purposes in a generation.

Every God-given vision must be carried, nurtured, and birthed, and this process demands spiritual strength, clarity, endurance, and grace. Just as physical birth requires strength and support, spiritual vision also requires sustained prayer and divine empowerment. Without God's help, even the most faithful servant can grow weary.

Scripture reveals that effective leadership flows from divine enablement, not human ability. In Isaiah 11:1–3, we see the sevenfold operation of the Spirit of the Lord: the Spirit of wisdom; the Spirit of understanding; the Spirit of counsel; the Spirit of might; the Spirit of knowledge; and the fear of the Lord.

These are essential for spiritual leadership. Without wisdom, leaders become reactive. Without understanding, vision becomes blurred. Without counsel, decisions become costly. Without might, perseverance fails. God never intended His servants to lead by intellect alone, but by the continual supply of His Spirit.

Furthermore, leaders must not only function, but they must also remain alive, burning, and spiritually revived. Ministry pressures, expectations, criticism, and spiritual warfare can slowly drain passion if leaders are not refreshed by God. Revival for leaders is not optional; it is essential. A revived leadership produces a revived people.

Scripture also reminds us that leaders do not lead in isolation—their families are part of the assignment. When families are neglected or attacked, ministry is weakened. Therefore, praying for leadership must include praying for their homes, marriages, children, and personal spiritual lives.

Hebrews 13:21 expresses God's desire for His servants:

“Make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well pleasing in His sight.”

This speaks of divine equipping—God working in them what is required to accomplish His will.

As we pray today, we are standing in the gap for the resident pastors and apostolic oversight of Word Alive Ministries International. We pray for strength to carry the vision, illumination to see clearly, wisdom to lead rightly, might to endure faithfully, and revival fire to burn continually in their hearts and homes.

DAY 8: FRIDAY, 10TH JULY 2026

Texts:

EXHORTATION

God has never viewed children as an afterthought in His redemptive plan. In Scripture, children are consistently presented as strategic vessels for God's purposes, carriers of covenant promises, and instruments of generational impact.

The Word of God declares in Isaiah 54:3 that "your seed shall inherit the nations and make the desolate cities inhabited." This means that the seed of the righteous is destined for greatness. They are not raised merely to survive in the world, but to subdue territories, influence nations, and advance the Kingdom of God.

In Isaiah 8:18, the prophet declares, "Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and for wonders." This reveals that children are not only future carriers of God's power—they are present instruments in His hands. God desires to mark them early, shape them early, and use them mightily.

The enemy understands this truth and therefore aggressively targets children through confusion, immorality, identity distortion, and spiritual apathy. But God's covenant promise stands firm:

"My Spirit that is upon thee... shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed." (Isaiah 59:21)

Revival that does not touch the next generation is incomplete. A revived church must be intentional about raising a Spirit-filled, Word-grounded, Christ-loving generation. Texts:

Romans 12:11; Matthew 28:18–20; 2 Timothy 1:6; Acts 13:2–3

EXHORTATION

True revival never terminates in personal blessing alone. Revival that does not flow into service becomes self-centered and incomplete. Whenever God revives His people, He also releases them into assignment. Fire that God ignites is meant to be poured out in ministry.

At Word Alive Ministries International, God has entrusted us with a clear and compelling mandate — the 5Ms:

Membership — bringing people into God's family; **Maturity** — raising them unto Christlikeness; **Ministry** — equipping them for service; **Missions** — sending them to the nations; **Magnifying** — glorifying the name of the Lord

This mandate cannot be fulfilled by giftedness alone; it requires fire.

Scripture exhorts us in *Romans 12:11*: “Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord.”

Fervency is spiritual heat. Slothfulness is spiritual coldness. Revival produces fervency—zeal that refuses to remain passive, indifferent, or comfortable. When revival truly touches a people, they do not ask, “What can the church do for me?” but “Lord, how can You use me?”

In 2 Timothy 1:6, Paul exhorted Timothy to stir up the fire for ministry.

Revival does not end at the altar; it continues in obedience, service, and mission. If revival does not produce labourers, it has not completed its work.

As we pray today, we are crying out for fire for service, that every member of Word Alive Ministries International will burn with passion for God's purposes, serve with joy, minister with power, and carry

the gospel to the nations of the earth. We pray that revival will break out into fervency of spirit, diligence in service, and effectiveness in ministry.

DAY 10: SUNDAY, 12TH JULY 2026

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

Texts:

Acts 2:1–4, Joel 2:28–29; Joel 3, Zechariah 4:6

EXHORTATION

Revival is not the product of human effort, organization, or strategy. Revival is the work of God, and the Holy Spirit is the vehicle through which revival comes. Wherever the Spirit of God is poured out, spiritual life is awakened, hearts are transformed, and the power of God is made manifest.

The clearest example of this truth is found in Acts 2. The disciples were not revived because of eloquent preaching or innovative methods; they were revived because the Holy Spirit came. When the Spirit descended like a rushing mighty wind and tongues of fire rested upon them, the result was immediate and undeniable—boldness replaced fear, power replaced weakness, and thousands were added to the Church in a single day. Revival followed the outpouring of the Spirit.

This outpouring was not accidental. It was the fulfillment of prophecy. In Joel 2:28–29, God promised that in the last days He would pour out His Spirit upon all flesh. That promise was not merely about spiritual experience—it was about revival, transformation, and harvest. Joel's prophecy reveals that when God pours out His Spirit, the result is awakening: sons and daughters prophesy, young men see visions, old men dream dreams, and servants are empowered. This is the language of revival.

Joel further shows us that the outpouring of the Spirit is God's response to repentance and turning of hearts. When God releases His Spirit, He restores what has been lost, heals what has been broken, and revives what has grown dry. Fire always follows the Spirit's movement, and fire always brings purification, power, and passion.

The Holy Spirit is not merely an influence; He is the presence of God. Where He is welcomed, revival flourishes. Where He is resisted, revival is hindered. A church may have programs, structures, and activity, yet remain spiritually dry if the Holy Spirit is absent or ignored.

Fresh fire is essential because spiritual fire can fade if not continually renewed. Believers can grow weary. Churches can become routine-driven. But when the Spirit is poured out afresh, prayer is revived, worship is ignited, the Word comes alive, and evangelistic boldness returns.

As we pray today, our cry is for the Person of the Holy Spirit. We ask Him to come again—to blow upon dry bones, to ignite fresh fire, and to produce revival in our hearts, our church, and our nation. Where the Spirit comes, revival must follow.

DAY 11: MONDAY, 13TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: THE HOLY SPIRIT AND FRESH FIRE

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, we come before You today on behalf of the members of Word Alive Ministries International, acknowledging that true revival comes only by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. We confess that without the Spirit, we can do nothing. We ask that You pour out Your Spirit afresh upon this ministry.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, You are the vehicle of revival. As You came on the Day of Pentecost and ignited a mighty awakening, we ask that You come again upon the members of this church. Blow upon every dry bone. Breathe life into weary hearts. Ignite fresh fire where passion has faded and zeal has grown cold.
- ▷ Father, pour out Your Spirit according to Your promise. Let sons and daughters be awakened. Let young men see visions. Let old men dream dreams. Let servants and handmaidens be empowered. Let spiritual gifts be stirred afresh. Let prayer be revived. Let worship burn with fire. Let the Word come alive again in the hearts of Your people.
- ▷ Lord, where routine has replaced hunger, restore longing for Your presence. Where activity has replaced intimacy, draw Your people back to fellowship with You. Let the fire of the Holy Spirit purify, empower, and renew every member of this ministry.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, fall afresh on Word Alive Ministries International. Consume complacency. Burn away carnality. Revive hearts. Rekindle love for holiness. Release power for witness and service. Let revival fire spread from individual hearts to the entire church.
- ▷ We welcome You, Holy Spirit. Move freely among Your people. Take Your rightful place in this church. Let revival break forth as You are poured out afresh.
- ▷ Thank You, Father, because You are faithful to Your promise. We receive fresh fire, renewed strength, and genuine revival in Word Alive Ministries International.
- ▷ As we continue to pray in other tongues, we yield ourselves to the Holy Spirit to make intercession through us in Jesus' name. Amen.

DAY 12: TUESDAY, 14TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: REVIVAL OF LOVE AND UNITY

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, REVIVE LOVE AND UNITY IN WORD ALIVE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL; UPROOT EVERY FORM OF STRIFE, DIVISION, AND CONFUSION, KNIT OUR HEARTS TOGETHER IN CHRIST, AND COMMAND YOUR ANOINTING AND BLESSING TO FLOW WHERE WE DWELL TOGETHER IN UNITY.*

Texts:

James 3:16, Psalm 133:1–3, John 13:34–35, Ephesians 4:3

EXHORTATION

Scripture is clear about the spiritual atmosphere in which God moves. Where there is strife, confusion and every evil work are inevitable. James 3:16 declares: “For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.”

This means strife is never neutral. Wherever strife is tolerated, confusion is released, discernment is weakened, relationships are damaged, and the door is opened for the enemy to operate freely. Where strife thrives, evil reigns.

Conversely, the Holy Spirit moves in an atmosphere of love and unity. God does not pour His anointing where bitterness, offence, division, and rivalry dominate. Revival cannot be sustained where love is absent, because love is the very nature of God.

Psalm 133 reveals one of the most powerful truths about unity: “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity... for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life forevermore.”

Unity is not merely pleasant, it is productive. Unity creates an environment where God commands blessing, releases anointing, and sustains spiritual life. The anointing flows downward when hearts are aligned upward toward God and outward toward one another.

Jesus Himself declared that love would be the defining evidence of true discipleship:

“By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.” (John 13:35)

This means unity is not optional for the Church; it is essential. Revival is hindered where offence is nurtured, suspicion is entertained, and unforgiveness is tolerated. But where love is revived, unity follows—and where unity prevails, the Spirit moves freely.

As we pray today, we are crying for a revival of love and unity among the membership of Word Alive Ministries International. We ask God to uproot strife, heal wounds, restore trust, and knit hearts together. We believe that as love is restored, confusion will flee, and as unity is established, the anointing and blessing of God will be released afresh.

DAY 12: TUESDAY, 14TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: REVIVAL OF LOVE AND UNITY

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, we come before You today on behalf of the members of Word Alive Ministries International. We acknowledge that You are a God of love, peace, and unity. We confess that where strife exists, confusion and every evil work follow. Lord, we ask that You cleanse this ministry from every seed of division.
- ▷ Father, uproot every form of strife among Your people. Remove bitterness, offence, envy, jealousy, pride, and unforgiveness. Heal wounds caused by words, actions, and misunderstandings. Restore broken trust. Let every spirit of division and confusion lose its hold over this church.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, move mightily among the members of WAMI. Create an atmosphere of love, humility, patience, and grace. Teach Your people to bear with one another in love. Help them to pursue peace and preserve unity in the bond of peace.
- ▷ Lord, revive genuine love in this ministry. Let hearts be softened. Let compassion replace suspicion. Let forgiveness flow freely. Let members see one another through the eyes of Christ. Remove every desire to compete, compare, or contend with one another.
- ▷ Father, let the unity described in Psalm 133 be established among Your people. Let brethren truly dwell together in unity. As unity is restored, command the blessing. Release fresh anointing. Release spiritual life. Release growth, strength, and divine increase in this ministry.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, take full control of the atmosphere in Word Alive Ministries International. Silence the voice of strife. Amplify the voice of love. Let the presence of God be felt strongly because hearts are aligned in unity.

- ▷ As we continue to pray in other tongues, we yield ourselves to the help of the Holy Spirit to pray and make intercession through us for a revival of love and unity in WAMI in Jesus' name. Amen.

DAY 13: WEDNESDAY, 15TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: REVIVAL OF FAMILIES

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, VISIT THE FAMILIES OF WORD ALIVE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL WITH REVIVAL; TURN THE HEARTS OF PARENTS AND CHILDREN TOWARD ONE ANOTHER, HEAL BROKEN RELATIONSHIPS, RESTORE UNITY AND PEACE IN OUR HOMES, AND MAKE OUR FAMILIES DWELLING PLACES OF YOUR PRESENCE.*

Texts:

Malachi 4:6, Acts 2:44, Joshua 24:15, Psalm 128

EXHORTATION

God designed the family as the primary place where faith, values, and godly legacy are transmitted. When families are healthy, the Church is strong; when families are broken, spiritual decline follows. For this reason, the enemy fiercely attacks marriages, parent-child relationships, and unity within homes.

Scripture makes it clear that revival is inseparable from family restoration. In Malachi 4:6, God gives a prophetic promise connected to revival: “And He shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers...”

This turning of hearts is not human psychology—it is a work of the Spirit. It is God reversing emotional distance, healing long-standing wounds, restoring love, and rebuilding broken bonds. Where revival comes, hearts are softened, forgiveness flows, and families are reconciled.

Revival does not merely fill churches; it heals homes.

In the early Church, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2 produced more than tongues and miracles—it produced unity. “And all that believed were together” (Acts 2:44). Unity was evidence of the Spirit’s work. The Holy Spirit always gathers; He does not scatter. He brings people together in love, understanding, and shared purpose.

When the Spirit moves, Hearts turn toward one another, Marriages are restored, Parents and children reconnect, Bitterness is replaced with compassion, Division gives way to unity.

Today, many families suffer from emotional distance, unresolved conflict, generational patterns, communication breakdown, and spiritual neglect. Yet God’s promise remains sure: revival brings restoration.

As we pray today, we are not merely asking for better families—we are crying out for a move of the Spirit that heals, unites, and restores. We believe God will turn hearts, rebuild family altars, and establish peace and unity in our homes.

DAY 13: WEDNESDAY, 15TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: WAMI MEMBERSHIP: REVIVAL OF FAMILIES

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, we come before You today on behalf of the families of Word Alive Ministries International. You are the God who instituted family, and You desire that homes reflect Your love, peace, and glory. Lord, we lift every household in this ministry before You and ask for a visitation of revival and restoration.
- ▷ Father, according to Your promise in Malachi 4:6, turn the hearts of fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers. Heal emotional wounds within families. Restore broken relationships. Where there has been distance, bring closeness. Where there has been silence, restore communication. Where there has been bitterness, release forgiveness and healing.
- ▷ Lord, let revival touch the families of this ministry. Remove hardness of heart, pride, resentment, and unresolved pain. Let love be rekindled. Let compassion flow again. Let understanding replace misunderstanding. Let grace prevail over offence.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, move in these families as You moved in the early Church. Let unity be restored in homes. Let peace reign in marriages. Let parents and children be knit together in love. Remove every spirit of strife, division, confusion, and disunity. Let the atmosphere of these homes reflect the presence of God.
- ▷ Father, restore family altars in Word Alive Ministries International. Rekindle prayer in homes. Restore the love for Your Word. Let worship rise from households. Make every family a dwelling place for Your presence and a testimony of Your grace.
- ▷ We pray for marriages, strengthen them. Heal strained relationships. Renew love and commitment. We pray for parents, grant them wisdom, patience, and grace. We pray for children, draw their hearts to You and to their parents.
- ▷ Lord, let the outpouring of the Holy Spirit result in unity, just as it did in Acts 2:44. Let families walk together in faith, love, and purpose. Let homes become centres of peace, joy, and spiritual growth.
- ▷ We declare that revival is restoring families in Word Alive Ministries International. Homes are healed. Hearts are turned. Unity is established. The presence of God dwells in these households.
- ▷ Thank You, Father, because You are faithful to Your Word. We receive restored families, strengthened homes, and renewed love in this ministry.
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to make intercession through me for families in WAMI in Jesus' name. Amen.

DAY 14: THURSDAY, 16TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PERSONAL: REVIVAL OF PRAYER AND INTERCESSION

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, REVIVE MY PRAYER LIFE; AWAKEN A DEEP HUNGER FOR YOUR PRESENCE, HELP ME BY YOUR SPIRIT TO PRAY WITHOUT FAINTING, MAKE ME A WATCHMAN AND INTERCESSOR, AND LET PRAYER BECOME A PLACE OF STRENGTH, INTIMACY, AND SUSTAINED REVIVAL IN MY LIFE.*

Texts:

Luke 18:1 — “Men ought always to pray, and not to faint.”

Isaiah 62:6–7, Romans 8:26

EXHORTATION

Prayer is the lifeline of spiritual vitality. When prayer fades, spiritual life weakens; when prayer is revived, revival follows. No genuine move of God in Scripture or church history ever occurred without a renewed emphasis on prayer and intercession.

Jesus Himself taught that men ought always to pray and not to faint (Luke 18:1). This statement reveals that prayerlessness leads to fainting; spiritual exhaustion, discouragement, and vulnerability to temptation. A praying believer remains alert, sensitive, and strong in the Spirit.

Revival of prayer is not merely about increasing prayer activities; it is about restoring a heart that longs to commune with God. Intercession flows from intimacy. When believers draw near to God, they naturally begin to carry burdens—not only for themselves, but for others, the Church, and the nation.

Isaiah 62:6–7 shows God’s desire for persistent intercessors—watchmen who will not keep silent day or night until God’s purposes are fulfilled. God looks for those who will stand in the gap, cry out persistently, and refuse to give up until heaven responds.

Yet Scripture also reminds us that we cannot pray effectively in our own strength. Romans 8:26 declares that the Holy Spirit helps our infirmities, especially when we do not know what or how to pray. Prayer must be Spirit-enabled to be sustained and effective.

Where prayer is revived:

- Spiritual sensitivity is restored
- Discernment is sharpened
- Burdens for souls increase
- Revival is sustained

As we pray today, our cry is for a revival of prayer and intercession—that prayer will no longer be a duty, but a delight; no longer occasional, but continual; no longer weak, but Spirit-empowered.

DAY 14: THURSDAY, 16TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PERSONAL: REVIVAL OF PRAYER AND INTERCESSION

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging my deep need for a revived prayer life. I confess that many times I have grown weary, distracted, or inconsistent in prayer. Lord, I ask that You revive my heart to pray again.
- ▷ Create in me a hunger for Your presence. Draw me back into intimate communion with You. Restore my desire to seek Your face, not only in moments of need, but as a daily pursuit. Teach me to pray always and not to faint.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, help my weakness in prayer. Awaken my spirit to the burden of intercession. Let me feel what You feel and pray what is on Your heart.
- ▷ Lord, make me a watchman in prayer. Place burdens upon my heart for souls, for the Church, and for the purposes of God in my generation. Give me grace to persevere in prayer until answers come. Remove every spirit of slumber, distraction, and discouragement.
- ▷ Revive prayer in my life. Let prayer become my first response, not my last resort. Let prayer be a place of strength, revelation, and transformation. Restore joy, confidence, and faith in my times of prayer.
- ▷ Father, I ask that through revived prayer, revival will be sustained in my life. Let my altar burn continually. Let my spirit remain alert and sensitive to Your voice.
- ▷ Thank You, Lord, because You are reviving my prayer life even now. I receive grace to pray, grace to intercede, and grace to remain faithful in prayer.
- ▷ As I continue to pray in other tongues, I yield myself to the Holy Spirit to revive my prayer altar in Jesus' name. Amen.

DAY 15: FRIDAY, 17TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PERSONAL: SUSTAINING THE FIRE OF REVIVAL

PRAYER POINT: *LORD, BY YOUR SPIRIT GRANT ME GRACE AND DIVINE STRENGTH TO KEEP THE FIRE OF REVIVAL BURNING; HELP ME REMAIN FERVENT IN SPIRIT, DISCIPLINED IN PRAYER AND THE WORD, OBEDIENT IN SERVICE, AND FAITHFUL UNTIL THE FIRE YOU IGNITED IN ME IS SUSTAINED TO THE END.*

Texts:

Leviticus 6:12–13, Romans 12:11, 2 Timothy 1:6, Zechariah 4:6

EXHORTATION

Revival is not meant to be a momentary experience; it is meant to become a sustained way of life. Throughout Scripture, God makes it clear that while He is the One who sends the fire, He also expects His people to keep the fire burning.

In Leviticus 6:12–13, God commanded that the fire on the altar must never go out. The fire was ignited by God, but the priests were responsible for tending it daily. This reveals a powerful spiritual principle: divine fire requires human stewardship, and that stewardship is only possible by divine grace.

The Holy Spirit is the source and igniter of revival. Every genuine revival in history began with the Spirit's outpouring. But many fires have gone out—not because God withdrew His power, but because believers grew careless, distracted, weary, or complacent. Spiritual fire fades when intimacy is neglected, prayer is abandoned, and obedience becomes optional.

Paul exhorted Timothy to “stir up the gift of God” within him (2 Timothy 1:6). This tells us that spiritual fire must be continually fanned. Romans 12:11 further instructs us to be “fervent in spirit, serving the Lord.” Fervency is sustained heat—it is consistent burning.

Yet Scripture also reminds us that sustaining the fire is not by human strength alone. Zechariah 4:6 declares, “Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit.” Without the ongoing help of the Holy Spirit, no believer can maintain spiritual intensity. We need grace—not just to start well, but to continue faithfully.

As we conclude this fast, our prayer is not, “Lord, light the fire again,” but rather, “Lord, help me keep the fire burning.” We ask for grace to remain disciplined, strength to remain obedient, hunger to remain alive, and sensitivity to remain responsive to the Holy Spirit.

The fast ends today, but revival must continue.

DAY 15: FRIDAY, 17TH JULY 2026

PRAYER FOCUS: PERSONAL: SUSTAINING THE FIRE OF REVIVAL

PRAYER IN THE UNDERSTANDING

- ▷ Heavenly Father, I thank You for this season of fasting, prayer, and revival. I acknowledge that You are the One who ignites spiritual fire by Your Spirit. Every encounter, every renewal, every stirring I have experienced has come from You, and I give You all the glory.
- ▷ Lord, as this fast comes to an end, I ask for grace to keep the fire burning. I recognize that without Your help, I cannot sustain what You have begun. Holy Spirit, help me to guard the fire You have ignited within me.
- ▷ Grant me grace to remain consistent in prayer. Give me discipline to stay in Your Word. Strengthen me to walk in obedience even when it is costly. Help me to resist distractions, complacency, and spiritual laziness. Do not allow familiarity or routine to quench this fire.
- ▷ Father, I ask for divine strength to persevere. When weariness comes, renew me. When pressure arises, uphold me. When temptation appears, empower me to overcome. Let my spirit remain fervent, my heart tender, and my conscience sensitive to Your voice.
- ▷ Holy Spirit, continue to fan the flame within me. Stir up every gift You have deposited in my life. Keep my hunger for You alive. Let my love for righteousness deepen. Let my hatred for sin remain strong. Help me to walk daily in reverence and humility before You.
- ▷ Lord, I commit to tending the altar of my heart. I choose intimacy over activity, obedience over convenience, and devotion over distraction. Let my life remain a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable unto You.
- ▷ I declare that this revival will not fade. The fire will not go out. By the grace of God and the help of the Holy Spirit, I will keep the fire burning until the end.
- ▷ Thank You, Father, for sustaining me. Thank You for grace, strength, and perseverance. I receive them now by faith.
In Jesus' mighty name I pray. Amen.
